- 2. The applicant is working as a Jailor, Group-I at Nagpur Prison. He took charge on 25.3.2023. His wife is posted at Judge in Labour Court, Ratnagiri from 7.7.2021. He submits that earlier the applicant has filed OA No.1099/2022. He relies on the order dated 19.12.2022-passed in OA No.1099/2022 by this Tribunal at Mumbai wherein the applicant earlier had requested to decide his representation for transfer at Yerwada, Satara or Ratnagiri on the ground of husband and wife unification policy of the Govt. 
