

In present case, the deceased Government servants were on the establishment of Superintending Engineer and Administrator, Command Area, Development Authority, Nashik. After the death of deceased Government servants, the Applicants have applied for compassionate appointment and their names were taken in the waiting list.</p> <p>4. The Collector, Nashik has taken review of the vacancies and found 34 vacancies on the establishment of Respondent No.2 - Deputy Director of Land Record, Nashik. The Collector, therefore, by communication dated 24.03.2023 directed Respondent No.2 to appoint the Applicants on their establishment on compassionate ground within seven days.</p>

6. The Respondents have not filed Affidavit in Reply till date. When the matter is taken up for admission and hearing, learned P.O. was directed to take instructions from the Respondent No.2 about compliance of direction given by the Collector by letter dated 25.04.2023.

7. Learned P.O. accordingly on instructions submits that now steps are being taken to appoint the Applicants on the establishment of Respondent No.2 and ~~also~~^{Police} verification report is called for. He further submits that ~~within~~[&] one month necessary orders will be issued.

8. Thus, the Applicants grievance is being redressed within a month.

9. In view of above, both Original Applications are disposed of with directions to Respondent No.2 - Deputy Director of Land Record, Nashik to pass appropriate orders of appointment to the Applicants within a month from today subject to suitability and other conditions on appropriate post.






