Learned Advocate for Applicant has submitted that on 20.08.2024 Applicant received a Phone Call from Clerk Mr. Ramesh Desai informing him to contact office so as to sign pension papers. The Applicant was shocked to receive a phone call as his Date of Birth is 20.10.1968 and he was to retire on 31.10.2026. So immediately the Applicant moved his representation dated 02.09.2024, but it was rejected by impugned order dated 30.09.2024 on the ground that the Applicant has not claimed relief to change of Date of Birth within 5 years from getting appointment.</p> <p>According to learned Advocate for Applicant the Date of Birth of the Applicant is mentioned on the first page of the service-book is 20.10.1966. According to him, the said Date of Birth is verified by concerned employee of Respondent No.4 on the basis of school leaving certificate. He has also invited my attention to the letter dated 20.09.2024 which Respondent No.4 sent to Respondent No.3 alongwith documents / docket sheet i.e. the school leaving certificate, copy of I.D. card which Apparently shows his Date of Birth as 20.10.1968.</p>

The Documents from Pg.17 such as Seniority List, Pay Slip which are mentioned by Respondent No.2 shows Date of Birth as 20.10.1968 and his retirement on 31.10.2026. Respondent No.2 has also mentioned in their Reply Clause No.5.1 that the same Date of Birth i.e. 10.10.1968 is shown in School Leaving Certificate, Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Police I.D. Card and Salary Slip of the petitioner.

4. Since, the concerned employee of Respondent No.4 has verified the Date of Birth which is mentioned on first page of the service book, reply of Respondent No.4 would be relevant so as to decide on merit, but learned P.O. is seeking one week time. Matter would take, time to conclude on matter. There would be vacation due to Diwali from 30.10.2024. Learned Advocate for Applicant also submits, on instruction from Applicant who is present in the court, that he may be allowed to perform his duties and he will not claim pay and allowances and that will be subject to Final Interim Relief / Final Decision on O.A. Considering these facts, it would be appropriate to exercise powers u/s. 24 of Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 so as to prevent any harm to the Applicant. There will not be any harm to the Respondent No.1 & 3 if they are directed to allow the Applicant to do his work since the pay and allowances of the Applicant would be subject to Final Decision on O.A. or on Final Order on Interim Relief. So on the basis of *prima-facie* material showing Date of Birth of the Applicant to be 20.10.1968, I pass Interim Order as under:-


