ORAL ORDER :

Heard Shri S.D. Joshi, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri M.P. Gude, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. Aggrieved by the order dated 16.10.2023, whereby the applicant has been transferred from Pundliknagar Police Station to the High Court Security, the applicant has approached this Tribunal by filing the present Original Application.

3. Shri S.D. Joshi, learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that within 9 months of her earlier Pundliknagar Police posting at Station, the applicant has been shifted vide impugned order to the High Court Security. Learned counsel submitted that though the provisions under Section 22N of the Maharashtra Police Act are stated to have invoked while issuing the impugned order, in fact, no such ground could have been used against the applicant for directing her transfer from Pundliknagar Police Station within a period of 9

months. Learned counsel submitted that there is nothing adverse against the applicant and she has been transferred with only object the of accommodating respondent No. 3 in her place. Learned counsel has also read out the provisions under Section 22N of the Maharashtra Police Act to buttress his contention that none of the circumstances, which are mentioned in the aforesaid section could have been invoked for directing the transfer of the applicant. Learned counsel submitted that the applicant has not yet handed over the charge and in the circumstances, has prayed for interim relief while issuing the notices to the respondents, thereby staying the effect and operation of the impugned order until further orders or till the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents. Learned counsel submitted that since the applicant has been transferred without any cogent reason, interim protection needs to be granted in her favour.

4. Shri M.P. Gude, learned Presenting Officer has submitted that respondent No. 3 has taken over the charge of the post of Police Inspector, Pundliknagar Police Station and he has placed on record the

document in that regard. Same is taken on record. Learned P.O. submitted that before issuance of the impugned order, the respondents have duly followed the procedure for effecting such transfer. Learned P.O. has tendered minutes of the meeting dated 16.10.2023 of the Police Establishment Board, wherein the decision was taken to direct the transfer of the applicant from Pundliknagar Police Station to the High Court Security. Same is taken on record. Learned P.O. submitted that the respondents will have to submit detailed affidavit in reply to the Original Application and hence, has sought time for submitting such affidavit in reply. Learned P.O. submitted that considering the prima-facie evidence, which the respondents have placed on record, there is no case made out for grant of interim relief as has been prayed by the applicant. Learned P.O. in the for circumstances, has prayed for rejecting the request of interim relief.

5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, respondent authorities. I have also perused the documents placed on record. The document at Annexure A-2

reveals that vide the order dated 10.01.2023 the applicant was shifted to Police Station Pundliknagar from Police Station Begumpura. The order at Annexure A-1 is the order dated 16.10.2023, which has been impugned in the present Original Application. From these documents, it is quite evident that the applicant has been shifted from Pundliknagar Police Station to High Court Security within a period of 9 months. If the impugned order is perused, it discloses that for certain administrative reasons, the applicant has been transferred vide the impugned order. Learned P.O. has placed on record the minutes of the meeting of Police Establishment Board held on 16.10.2023, wherein the Police Establishment Board recommended the transfer of the applicant at High Court Security. The minutes of meeting of the Police Establishment Board reveal that the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Osmanpura has forwarded two reports one on 18.08.2023 and another on 05.09.2023 in respect of working style of the present applicant, as well as, about the delinquency of the applicant. The minutes of Police Establishment Board revealed that the posting of the applicant at

Pundliknagar Police Station was for the temporary period and the regular appointment was required to be issued to the applicant and on the aforesaid 2 grounds, the impugned order is stated to have been passed, whereby the applicant is posted at High Court Security, Aurangabad.

6. Considering the facts as aforesaid, it appears to me that when the transfer is made within the area of Aurangabad itself, apparently no prejudice can be said to have been caused to the applicant. It is however, the contention of the applicant that shifting of the Police Officer from one Police Station to another before completing tenure is taken as a stigma and raises doubt about the integrity of the said officer. In the minutes of the Police Establishment Board, there is reference of 2 reports submitted by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Osmanpura, in respect of delinquency of the applicant. The said reports are not before this Tribunal at this juncture. In view of the fact that the Police Establishment Board has considered the matter, which is the competent and independent body and has recommended the transfer of the

applicant, it is difficult at this juncture to accept the allegations as are made by the applicant that the transfer has been effected only with the object of accommodating respondent No. 3 in her place. Unless the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents and all relevant facts are brought on record, no effective decision can be taken in the present matter. It has also come on record that the respondent No. 3 has taken over the charge of the post of Police Inspector of Police Station Pundliknagar.

7. For the reasons stated above, it does not appear to me that the applicant has made out any strong prima-facie case for granting interim relief as has been claimed by her. In the circumstances, I am not inclined to accept the said request and prefer to issue notices to the respondents to file affidavit in reply to the contentions raised in the Original Application. The respondents shall file affidavit in reply within two weeks. Hence, the following order :-

(i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 30.10.2023.

2. It is the case of the present applicant that though he and respondent No. 3 both have secured equal marks and both are on the equal footings, so far as qualification, category etc. are concerned. So far as the age is concerned, the applicant is elder than respondent No. 3 and, as such, he is entitled to get appointment. However, respondent No. 2, MPSC has recommended the name of respondent No. 3 to respondent No. 1. The legality of modified rules is challenged. However, earlier rules are not produced on record. Having considered the facts as aforesaid though, the learned counsel has sought stay for issuance of the appointment order in favour of respondent No. 3 till the decision of the present O.A., we deem it appropriate to observe that if appointment order is issued in favour of

2. The present Original Application is filed seeking the following reliefs: -

"A. To allow this Original Application.

B. To direct the respondent authorities to consider the claim of the applicant for promotion from the post of Account Officer, Group-B to the post of Maharashtra Finance Account Services, Group-A (Assistant Director), pursuant to the Departmental Promotion Committee meeting held on 17.06.2015, 26.09.2017, 17.11.2021 and 24.01.2023 and for that purpose necessary directions may kindly be issued.

C. To direct the respondent authorities to consider the claim of the applicant for promotion from the cadre of Account Officer, Group-B to the cadre of Maharashtra Finance Account Services, Group-A (Assistant Director) by opening the sealed cover procedure and for that purpose necessary orders may kindly be passed."

3. The applicant was suspended vide order dated 24.9.2015 on account of a criminal case registered against him for the offence under the prevention of corruption Act. On 16.5.2017 the suspension order was revoked. The departmental enquiry was also conducted against the applicant and was held guilty for the misconduct alleged against him in the said enquiry and punishment of withholding of two increments falling on 1.7.2021 and 1.7.2022 was imposed on him. In the meanwhile period the DPC meetings were held in the year 2015, 2017, 2021 and lastly in 2023. The applicant was however, not considered for his promotion in the aforesaid DPCs on the ground that the criminal prosecution was pending against The Government Resolution dated 15.12.2017 lays him down the procedure for awarding promotions to the employees against whom departmental enquiry or criminal prosecution is pending. Clause 9 of the said Government Resolution reads thus:-

4. It is the contention of the applicant that the period of more than 2 years has already passed after the DPC meeting was held in the year 2017, but the applicant was not considered for promotion on the ground that criminal prosecution is pending against him. In such circumstances, clause 9 reproduced hereinabove empowers the appointing authority to take a conscious

decision in respect of the promotion of the delinquent employee by considering the aspects which are enlisted below the said clause 9. Since it is the only prayer of the applicant that the authorities shall review his matter in view of the provisions made under clause 9 of the G.R. dated 15.12.2017 and in view of the fact that learned Chief Presenting Officer has also consented for disposing of the present O.A. by giving necessary directions in consonance with clause 9 of the G.R. dated 15.12.2017, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the O.A. at the initial stage itself with the following direction: -

<u>O R D E R</u>

(i) As provided under clause 9 of the G.R. dated 15.12.2017 the competent authority/appointing authority shall take a conscious decision in respect of the promotion to the present applicant by considering the points A to G of clause 9 of the G.R. dated 15.12.2017 within 8 weeks from the date of this order and communicate the order to the applicant.

(ii) The Original Application stands disposed of in the aforesaid term. There shall be no order as to costs.

2. In the scrutiny of this matter the Office has raised an objection as about maintainability of the present application before this Tribunal having regard to the fact that the matter pertains to autonomous Institutions. The grievance of the applicants is that the post of Principal of the Engineering Colleges at Karad, Amravati, Jalgaon and Aurangabad are decided to be filled in by making contractual appointment for a particular period, which is contrary to the provisions under the relevant recruitment rules.

3. Insofar as the office objection raised, the learned counsel for the applicants submitted that the autonomy of these Institutions is limited or

restricted to the academic excellence only and for all other purposes these are the Institutions controlled by the State Government. Learned counsel submits that even the transfers of the employees working in these Institutions are made by the Government and may such Original Applications challenging such transfer orders are filed before the Tribunal and are entertained by this Tribunal. Learned counsel further submitted that since Career Assured Progression Scheme is not implemented, several Officers are deprived of pay scale of higher post. The applicants are, therefore, seeking directions against the respondents by way of interim relief restraining them from making the appointments of the Principals on contractual basis.

4. Learned Chief Presenting Officer submitted that the autonomy of these Institutions is not restricted only to academic excellence but the autonomy is for all purposes. The learned C.P.O. sought time to seek instructions and file the affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondents.

5. We have considered the submissions made on behalf of both the sides and also gone through the documents placed on record. The conflicting status made about of the statements are as Government Engineering Colleges at Aurangabad, Amravati, Jalgaon & Karad. Neither the applicants nor the respondents have placed on record any such concrete evidence on the basis of which the status of aforesaid Colleges, whether autonomous the or controlled by the Government, can be determined. In the circumstances, it is difficult to accept the request of the applicants to stay the appointments of Principals on contractual basis in the aforesaid Government Engineering Colleges. However, the contentions as are raised by the applicants in the Original Application cannot be wholly discarded. In the aforesaid circumstances, we deem it appropriate to pass the following order :-

ORDER

(i) Keeping the issue of jurisdiction open, issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 22.11.2023.

(ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

(iii) Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

(iv) This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

(v) The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicants are directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

2. The applicant had applied for the post of Planning Assistant (Group-B, Non Gazetted). As is contended in the Original Application, the applicant belongs to Other Backward Class (for short OBC) and he had therefore applied claiming reservation for the said class. It is further contended that the applicant secured 150.202 marks in the written examination and in the list of recommended candidates in Open-General his name is included at Sr. No. 26. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that 36 posts are for Open-General class and, as such, the applicant is liable to be selected as Open-General candidate. Learned counsel submitted that, however, on the ground that the

applicant is not possessing non-creamy layer certificate valid up to 31.3.2023, the respondents are denying him appointment.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that after filing of the present Original Application the applicant has received a communication dated 8.9.2023, whereby the respondents have informed him that his recommendation has been cancelled on the aforesaid ground. Learned counsel submits that the applicant will be taking appropriate steps to bring the said fact on record by amending the present application.

4. Learned counsel further submitted that applicant submitted separate had 02 non-creamy layer certificates one was valid till 31.3.2022 and another up to 31.3.2026. The learned counsel further submitted that 02 clauses relating to non-creamy layer certificates are differently worded. Learned counsel submitted that on incorrect interpretation of the relevant provisions and ignoring the documents on record, the respondents have declined to consider the candidature of the

applicant. Learned counsel, in the circumstances, has prayed for staying further process and sought directions against the respondents not to give appointment till the present application is decided.

5. Learned Presenting Officer has sought time to seek instructions and file the affidavit in reply of the respondents. Learned Presenting Officer submits that apparently there appears no mistake on the part of the respondents in refusing appointment to the applicant, since the applicant has not complied with the conditions in the advertisement. Learned P.O., in the circumstances, has prayed for rejecting the request of the applicant for interim relief.

6. We have considered the arguments advanced by both the sides. It is not in dispute that the applicant has secured 150.202 marks in the written examination on the basis of which his name is included at sr. no. 26 in the list of recommended candidates for Open-General class. When the applicant on his merit secured the seat in Open Class, prima-facie, it appears incorrect that he was required to furnish Non-creamy layer certificate.

Secondly, the non-creamy layer certificates filed on record and which according to applicant he had produced before the Scrutiny Authority, it reveals that it covers the period for which the certificate was called for. Prima-facie, it appears that the authorities concerned have without considering the documents on record have rejected the claim of the applicant. In the circumstances we deem it appropriate to pass the following order :-

(ii) Respondents are directed to keep one post of Planning Assistant (Group-B, Non Gazetted) vacant until further orders from this Tribunal.
