2. This Original Application is filed challenging the alleged midterm and mid-tenure transfer order of the applicant dated 11.01.2023 (Annex. A-2) issued by the respondent No.1, whereby the applicant has been transferred from the post of Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Tal. and Dist. Latur to the post of Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Nilanga Tal. Nilanga Dist. Latur.

3. The applicant was transferred to the present posting as Assistant Registrar Co-operative Societies, Tal. and Dist. Latur by transferring him from Surgana Dist. Nashik as per transfer order dated 05.08.2021 (part of Annex. A-1 collectively). The applicant took the charge of his posting at Latur on 09.08.2021 as reflected in CTC (part of Annex. A-1 collectively). The impugned order of transfer is dated

11.01.2023 (Annex. A-2). It is issued hardly within the period of one year and five months. The applicant belongs to Group -B (Gazetted) and therefore, his normal tenure is of three years as per Section 3 of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as "the Transfer Act" for short). Hence, it is mid-tenure transfer order. The impugned order is also midterm being issued in the month of January and not being issued in the month of April or May.

4. It is also contended that the applicant while holding the said post of Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies at Latur is being appointed as the Returning Officer for holding election of Yashwant Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd., Latur as per order dated 21.11.2011 (Annex. A-1 (a) to the additional affidavit) issued by the State Co-operative Election Authority, Maharashtra State, Pune. In clause No. 12 of the said order, it is stated as follow:-

“ निवडणूक प्रक्रिया पूर्ण होण्यापूर्वी निवडणूक निर्णय अधिकाऱ्यांची सध्याच्या पदावरून अन्यत्र बदली झाल्यास त्यांना निवडणूक प्रक्रिया पूर्ण होईपर्यंत कार्यमुक्त करण्यात येऊ नये. ”

5. It is further submitted that by further order dated 28.12.2022 (Annex. A-1(b) to the additional affidavit) election program is declared whereby the result of the said election would be declared on 12.02.2023.

6. In view of above, learned Advocate for the applicant submitted that the impugned order of transfer of the applicant is not in accordance with law and no exceptional circumstances or special case is reflected from the impugned order. Moreover, he further submitted that the applicant's wife is working as Judicial Officer at Latur and by impugned order his posting at Latur is also disturbed in breach of couple convenience. He further submitted that as per the stipulation laid down in order dated 21.11.2022 (Annex. A-1 (a) to the additional affidavit), the applicant cannot be relieved from his post till completion of election program.

7. On the other hand, learned P.O. representing the respondents opposed the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and submitted that the impugned order is issued in accordance with law by

taking recourse to Section 4 (4) (2), 4(5) and (6) of the Transfer Act. He further submitted that the applicant has already been relieved as reflected in the copy of order dated 13.01.2023 (Annex. A-4) produced by the applicant himself.

8. As regards the relieving of the applicant, learned Advocate for the applicant on instructions submitted that Shri S.S. Kulkarni to whom the charge was to be given is not on duty and has taken a leave and therefore, subsequent order dated 16.01.2023 (Annex. A-1 (d) to the additional affidavit) is issued directing to hand over the charge to one Mr. M.S. Latpate.

9. After having considered the Original Application, additional affidavit, annexures to both and arguments advanced on behalf of both the parties, I find that in the impugned order of transfer of the applicant dated 11.01.2023 (Annex. A-2), there is mention of adherence to the provisions of Section 4 (4) (2), 4 (5) and (6) of the Transfer Act applicable to midterm and mid-tenure order. No doubt, minutes of Civil Services Board in that regard are not placed on record on behalf of the

respondents. However, unless some apparent malafide intention is shown behind the order, mention of compliance of provisions of Transfer Act cannot be ignored.

10. However, that apart, the applicant while working as Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Latur has been appointed as Returning Officer for election of Yashwant Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd., Latur by virtue of order dated 21.11.2022. In clause No. 12 of the said order reproduced above would show that during election program if transfer of Returning Officer is issued, such officer cannot be relieved till completion of election program. The applicant has placed on record further order dated 28.12.2022 (Annex. A-1 (b) to the additional affidavit) issued by the State Co-operative Election Authority, Maharashtra State, Pune which shows that the election program of the bank would be completing on 12.02.2023 when the result of the election would be declared.

11. Perusal of the impugned transfer order, however, does not show that the stipulation mentioned in the order dated 21.11.2022 (Annex. A-

1 (a)) is taken care of. Due care by all the concerned ought to have taken while issuing impugned transfer order. Even if it is considered that the respondent No.1 has issued transfer order of the applicant in ignorance of election of Yashwant Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd., Latur being declared by virtue of order dated 21.11.2011 and election program by order dated 28.12.2011 (Annex. A-1 (b)), the applicant cannot be made to suffer for non compliance of stipulation.

12. In view of the same, in my considered opinion, the impugned order prima-facie suffers from contravention of the stipulation mentioned in order dated 21.11.2022 (Annex. A-1 (a)) issued by State Co-operative Election Authority, Maharashtra State, Pune. The said stipulation provides that the applicant who is appointed as Returning Officer for election of Yashwant Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd., Pune cannot be relieved from his present post till 12.02.2023 on which date the result would be declared. In view of the same, it is a fit case to grant stay to the execution and implementation of impugned order dated 11.01.2023 for limited period till 12.02.2023. It is ordered accordingly.
