- 1. Heard Shri A.V. Patil, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri K.B. Bhise, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The applicant seeks urgent relief for a direction to the MPSC to interview him on one of the two dates i.e. 28th and 29th January, 2016 on which dates other candidates who will be interviewed pursuant to the directions of this Tribunal in a number of OAs. As a matter of fact such matters came up before one of us [Coram: Shri R.B. Malik, Member (J)] and also the Hon'ble Chairman in one group of OAs and directions came to be given as a result of which the interview process which came to an end on

30.12.2015 has now been in the manner of speaking extended for two more dates as just mentioned. But by order of 12.1.2016 in a group of OAs including OAs No.28 and 29 of 2016 Dr. Archana N. Bhingare Versus State of Maharashtra & Ors. it has been made clear that thence forth no further OAs will be considered for interim order for being interviewed lest the whole process became endless. In para 7 thereof however it was clarified that others so similarly placed as those applicants would not be rendered remediless inasmuch as if they were able to establish their case after the final hearing of the OAs the Tribunal will be fully competent to direct their interviews.

- Now, it is no doubt true that the present OA is in a slightly different factual context. Here the applicant apparently applied through category of physically handicapped but it seems that the MPSC held that he did not answer the requirements for the said post, post short listing criteria. We make it clear that as of now we make no pronouncement or expression of opinion about the short-listing criteria aspect of the matter. Broadly so speaking there is power to prescribe the said criteria but at the same time it is not completely immune from the judicial scrutiny with the limitations that are there in a judicial review of an administrative action.
- In this particular matter on applicant's own showing he came to know on 17.12.2015 that may be there was some problem with regard to his eligibility because of which he made a representation to the MPSC which in fact has not been responded to. He had sufficient time from 17.12.2015 to 30.12.2015 to file an OA which he did not avail of. However, as just mentioned MPSC has

their own reasons and while we do not make any detailed observations but it appears that the applicant may while submitting the application online have submitted the details which may not have been exactly accurate. But as we mentioned just now we express no final opinion thereabout.

- 5. It must be remembered that at the moment we are at the stage of interim order and applying the general principles that one must do in matters at this stage on facts it is not possible to give a direction to allow the applicant to be interviewed. However, as mentioned in the order of this Tribunal dated 12.1.2016 if this applicant also will succeed in establishing his case on merits in the OA then appropriate directions will be given and in that view of the matter the applicant does not become completely remediless. In that view of the matter and with that liberty no other orders as of today.
- 6. Issue notice returnable on 16.2.2016.
