- 4. Learned PO seeks time to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply' in this regard on behalf of 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai'.
- 5. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' of 'Transport Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' to clarify if the posts of 'Stenographer (Lower Grade)' are not attached individually to officers serving on these posts of 24 R.T.O.'s. If it is not so, then to specify the designation of officer under 'R.T.O. Thane' including 'Deputy R.T.O.'s or A.R.T.O.'s, to whom the post of 'Stenographer (Lower Grade)' has been attached; as there is no such mention in 'Office Order' dated 25.04.2023 of 'Deputy R.T.O., Thane' which only directs Applicant to work in 'Old Office Building' of 'R.T.O. Thane'.

- Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant was working on post of 'Education Officer (Primary), Z.P., Sangli' and has been posted as 'Divisional Joint Secretary' in 'Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary, Divisional Education Board' at 'Ratnagiri' by 'Transfer Order' dated 15:03.2024 of 'School Education and Sports Department'.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that Applicant was posted on promotion to post of 'Education Officer (Primary), Z.P., Sangli' by 'Transfer Order' dated 23.02.2022 of 'School Education and Sports Department'. Therefore, Applicant is yet to complete 'Normal Tenure' of '3 Years' as per provisions of 'Section 3(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then refers to 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2022 of 'School Education and Sports Department' by which 'Respondent No.2' upon promotion had been posted as 'Assistant Commissioner' in 'Maharashtra State, Examination Council' at 'Pune' but subsequently by 'Transfer Order's 29.12.2022 of 'School Education & Sports Department' soon, came to be transferred to post of 'Education Officer (Plan), Z.P., Pune'.

### Tribunal's orders

- 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant draws attention to provisions of 'Rule 8' of 'Maharashtra Government Apartment of Revenue Divisions for appointment of nomination and promotion to the posts in Group A and Group B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) Rules, 2021 which makes it mandatory to complete '3 Years' tenure in allotted 'Revenue Divisions' before any 'Government Servant' can be considered as being eligible for transfer under 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.
- 6. Learned Advocate for Applicant also mentions about 'Specific Guidelines' issued by 'G.A.D.' Circular dated 11.02.2015 to restrain 'Mid-Term Transfers' being effected even on requests made by 'Government Servants'.
- 7. Learned P.O. produces copy of the 'File Notings' of 'School Education and Sports Department' so as to emphasize that 'Competent Transferring Authority' and next 'Superior Transferring Authority' had approved the transfers of both 'Applicant' and 'Respondent No.2' in exercise of 'Statutory Powers' under 'Section 4(4)(ii)' and 'Section 4(5)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.
- The perusal of 'File Notings' of 'School Education and Sports Department' including the 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024 reveal that transfers of both 'Applicant' and 'Respondent No.2' had not been recommended by 'C.S.B.' as both had not completed their 'Normal Tenures' of '3 Years'. However, the 'Competent Transferring Authority' and next 'Superior Transferring Authority' overruled the recommendations made by 'C.S.B.' and directed 'Mid-Term Transfers' to be made for both 'Applicant' and 'Respondent No.2'. However, the 'File Notings' | of 'School Education and Sports Department' do not plausible reasons mentions any recommendations made by 'C.S.B.' were not accepted and changed with direct ions to effect transfer of 'Applicant' and 'Respondent No.2' which resulted in contravention of principles laid down in land mark Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India' in (2013) 15 SCC\_732 (T.S.R. Subramanian and Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.).

#### Tribunal's orders

- 9. The 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024 also reveals that although no requests had been made by Applicant for any transfer, the Respondent No.2 had infact submitted requested for transfer from post of 'Education Officer (Plan), Z.P. Pune'.
- 10. The facts and circumstances of the case tilt the 'Balance of Convenience' at this stage in favour of Applicant. Hence, it is directed that 'Transfer Order' dated 15.03.2024 of 'School Education and Sports Department' is not to be implemented Applicant is accordingly granted 'Interim Relief' to continue to service on post of 'Education Officer (Primary), Z.P. Sangli'.
- 11. The learned P.O. is informed to telephonically convey the orders to 'Respondent No.1 Principal Secretary, Primary Education and Sports Department.'
- 12. The office objections if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 13. Issue notice before admission returnable on 02.04.2024.
- 14. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

- 2. In this M.A. the State wants to press that the order of the Tribunal dated 07.11.2022 passed in O.A.No.644/2022 with M.A.No.471/2022 is to be recalled. The issue involved is about reservation of Transgender. In the present case the applicant has appeared for the examination in the Recruitment process of Police Sub Inspector and by order dated 07.11.2022 the Tribunal directed the Respondents to keep one post of PSI reserved for transgender in Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) category (in Maharashtra State OBC category). Paragraph 5 of order dated 07.11.2022 reads as below:
  - "5. We hereby direct the Respondents to keep one post of PSI reserved for transgender in Socially and Educationally Backward Classes for citizens in this examination and thereafter at all the stages as only one applicant has approached this Tribunal."
- 3. This order was passed on the basis of directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in paragraph 135.3 of the judgment in the case of National Legal Services Authority Versus Union of India and other reported in (2014) 5 SCC 438.
- Learned Counsel has submitted that Respondents (Original Applicants) had challenged this O.A. on the ground of maintainability. Learned Counsel has pointed out that the Applicants (Org. Respds) have substantially complied with the order the M.P.S.C. dated 07.11.2022 and substantially complied with the order as one post was reserved at the time of declaration of Preliminary Examination. On the basis of that the applicant was allowed to appear for the Main Examination. However when the result of Main Examination was declared after M.A. was filed i.e., on 13.03.2024. M.P.S.C. dropped the reservation of

Transgender thereby the order passed by the Tribunal in the said O.A. and thus once it is complied with earlier at certain stage, the order cannot be recalled. Learned Counsel has submitted that in the process of challenging order dated 29.11.2023 passed in O.A.No.1121/2022 with M.A.No.244/2023 with O.A.No.401/2023 with O.A.No.928/2023. Hence, M.A. may be disposed of.

- Learned C.P.O. has submitted that this Tribunal while deciding the judgment dated 29.11.2023 passed in O.A.No.1121/2022 with M.A.No.244/2023 with O.A.No.401/2023 with O.A.No.928/2023 the Tribunal has directed to consider the candidates for appointment in Transgender if they secure more than 50% of the marks. Learned C.P.O. has submitted that on the basis of this judgment the M.P.S.C. found that the marks obtained by the present applicants are not upto 50%, hence the Applicants cannot be considered by the M.P.S.C. However, the Tribunal has directed the Respondents to keep one post reserved for Transgender. However such reservation for Transgender is not given in order dated 29.11.2023. Learned C.P.O. therefore prays that the order be recalled on this background along with the order of keeping one post reserved
- 6. Admittedly it is not a Review Application and the application for modification is as good as asking to decide the matter again. This cannot be done at the level of Tribunal, but for the applicants who have challenged the order before the Hon'ble High Court.
- 7. M.A. filed for recalling order amounts to deciding the issue afresh. We are of the view that this cannot be done at this stage at all especially when the issue is pending before the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition No.7209/2022. So also learned C.P.O. confirms that our earlier judgment dated 29.11.2023 passed in O.A.No.1121/2022 with M.A.No.244/2023 with O.A.No.401/2023 with O.A.No.928/2023 stating that Transgender category securing 50% should be considered while giving employment.
- 8. Under such circumstances, when the issue is going to be considered by the Hon'ble High Court this matter cannot be re-decided or recalled. The impugned order, if was not acceptable to the State, the State should have challenged the order before the HC much earlier which is not done by the State, the Sealed cover which was given by the Respondents is handed over to them without opening the same.

- 2. We have examined the copy of purshis dated 6.2.2024 in OA No.454/2022 filed before Nagpur Bench of this Tribunal. We have also examined the purshis filed in OA No.454/2022 by respondent no.4 National Medical Commission (NMC) clearly pointing out that in cases where Post Graduate qualified candidates were directly appointed to the post of Assistant Professor by the State Government, the experience of such students as Assistant Professor may be counted against the requirement of one year Senior Resident.
- 3. Ld. CPO produces letter dated 18.1.2024 written by Medical Education & Drugs Department, Mumbai to the Ld. CPO. Para 2 of the said letter reads as under:

"That in the instant matter Senior Residency of one year has been made mandatory vide notification dated 5.6,2017. The same is annexed herewith as Annexure A. However, in the special circumstances, of the instant cases where Post Graduate qualified candidates were directly appointed to the post of Assistant Professor by the State Govt., the experience of such students as Assistant Professors may be counted against the requirement of one-year senior residency. This pursis is filed in view of instructions received by e-mail dated 3.5.2023."

- 4. We would like to note that by order dated 31.3.2023 we have directed the respondents to keep one post of Assistant Professor of Forensic Medicine vacant.
- 5. In view of the above, we direct that if the applicant is found meritorious and otherwise eligible, he is to be recommended to the post of Assistant Professor as per merit. With these directions the OA is disposed off. No order as to costs.
