Thus it appears that unless Tribunal issue specific direction to take necessary steps, Respondents would not budge. They are simply sitting over the matter for nearly about three years which shows total lethargy, inaction and negligence. 

ORDER

- 1) Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent.
- 2) The Applicant has challenged Transfer order dated 17.04.2023 whereby he is transferred mid-term and mid-tenure from the post of Executive Engineer, P.W.D. Solapur to Executive Engineer, Municipal Council, Directorate of Administration, Sangli on vacant post.
- 3) Learned Advocate for the Applicant sought interim relief *inter-alia* contending that the Applicant's parent Department being P.W.D. there could be no transfer on the establishment of Municipal Council Administration and it could be permissible only by way of deputation. He has pointed out that the procedure for deputation as contemplated in G.R. dated 17.12.2016 and 16.02.2018 are applicable here and in absence of deputation procedure the impugned order is bad in law.
- 4) Per Contra, learned P.O. submits that in view of G.R. dated 16.02.2018 the procedure for deputation is not necessary and transfers



are required to be made as per Transfer Act, 2005. She has further pointed out that the Applicant is transferred on the account of default report submitted by Superintending Engineer with the approval of Civil Services Board and Hon'ble Chief Minister.

5) Admittedly, the Applicant parent Department is PWD. Before impugned order he was posted in PWD, Solapur but now by impugned order he is transferred on the establishment of Directorate of Municipal Administration, Sangli.

6) Perusal of file reveals that Chief Engineer by his letter dated 07.02.2023 attributed several lapses and mis-conduct particularly for non-performance resulting into delay in completion of project and recommended his transfer on Non-Executive Post. Matter was placed before CSB which recommended for his Transfer and it was approved by Hon'ble Chief Minister competent authority for such mid-term and mid-tenure transfer. Thus *prima-facie* there is no compliance of provision of Transfer Act, 2005.

7) In sofaras issue of applicability of procedure for deputation is concerned, *prima-facie* as per G.R. dated 16.02.2018, such transfers are to be made in observance of Transfer Act, 2005.

8) In the fact and circumstances of the case whether Respondents were required to observe the procedure for deputation as contemplated in G.R. dated 17.12.2016 and 16.12.2018 is debatable which needs to be considered on merit. As such in present case, I am not inclined to grant interim relief as prayed for.

9) The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

10) Issue notice before admission returnable on 14.06.2023.

11) Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed.
