


ORDER

1. Heard Shri A.A. Desai, Shri S. Kusale, Shri M.D. Lonkar, Shri K.R. Jagdale and Shri V.P. Potbhare, the learned Advocate for the Applicants and Shri S.K. Nair, the Special Counsel with Ms. N.G. Gohad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. This group of Original Applications was heard from time to time.
3. Before two dates, the learned Special Counsel had tendered the draft minutes of order, which ran about 32 pages. A copy of the draft minutes was furnished to the Advocates appearing for both sides.

4. The submission of the learned Special Counsel for State through minutes of order, in summary is as follows :-

- (a) The Government had received list of candidates selected by M.P.S.C. for appointment as Dental Surgeons.
- (b) Government has issued appointment orders and number of appointees have already joined.
- (c) In view of whatever that had transpired from the points which have been raised in present Original Applications and during hearing of oral submissions, it was considered by the Government that it is necessary to scrutinize those points.
- (d) Upon scrutiny it has been noticed that certain objections raised by the applicants as regards deficiency in eligibility of various candidates needs further scrutiny. For that purpose, exercise of verification of eligibility of various candidates, based on Recruitment Rules & Advertisement was undertaken by the Government.
- (e) During scrutiny it was noticed that thorough scrutiny and verification of eligibility of all candidates is required to be re-verified, based on Recruitment Rules / Advertisement.
- (f) It is necessary to undertake the scrutiny by giving opportunity to the candidates concerned.
- (g) This exercise is in fact liable to be done by M.P.S.C. and M.P.S.C. may be directed to undertake the same.
- (h) In view that candidates are already appointed and present O.A. is pending, it is considered necessary that this exercise be done after taking leave from this Tribunal.
- (i) It is also necessary to file in unfilled vacancies from waiting list.
- (j) Direction and leave for scrutiny and further action needs to be granted, and may be granted.

5. The response of learned Advocates for the Applicants and also of the Advocates for the Respondents to the text, proposal and prayer emerging through stance of State, was called.



6. Learned Advocates for the Applicants have argued that :-
- (a) The scope of the relief sought in the Original Applications is far larger.
 - (b) The statement or proposal which is coming forward on behalf of Government cannot suffice to meet the ends of justice as it does not cover all prayers and grievances of applicants.
 - (c) Therefore applicants have objection to the course of action which is proposed by the Government.
 - (d) The Original Applications be heard and let the status of parties be governed by final order as may be passed.
7. Learned Advocates for the Respondents have submitted as follows :-
- (a) The candidates have been appointed, after due verification of their credentials and in accordance to the Recruitment Rules and existing practice of the State Government.
 - (b) It is not open to have the eligibility re-scrutinized without adjudication of the O.A..
 - (c) Respondents strongly object to the exercise proposed by the Government, and pray that the proposal be rejected.
8. After hearing all the parties for considerable time this Tribunal, it prima facie emerges that :-
- (a) The adherence to eligibility according to Recruitment Rules is mandatory.
 - (b) Deviation to Recruitment Rules after process of selection advances, would prejudice large number of aspirants, and would result in denial of fair opportunity of consideration.
 - (c) Considering the challenge and prima facie observation of the Government that certain candidates are selected though deficiencies in qualification exists, needs advertence and scrutiny.
 - (d) Similarly, the exercise which Government proposes to undertake, if not done, may result in depriving employment to candidates who may be having merit amongst eligible candidates, and continue in employment, such candidates who are not eligible.

- (e) The Secretary can be done during pendency of Original Applications, though outcome can be kept in abeyance till decision of O.A., to protect the ends of justice.

9. Therefore, though parties are objecting, ultimately the aspect of eligibility as per Recruitment Rules which goes to the root of case, deserves to be examined, to protect the ends of justice.

10. Though the State Government wants that the exercise of scrutiny be done by M.P.S.C., since Government has found out the deficiencies it would be proper that the exercise be done by the Government. M.P.S.C. would be bound to furnish entire record including the documents as may be available with M.P.S.C., on the basis of which eligibility of candidates who were selected for interview was decided by M.P.S.C..

11. Therefore, conducting of scrutiny even during the pendency of O.A., to the extent of candidates who are declared selected by M.P.S.C. for interview deserves to be ordered pending, hearing and disposal of present Original Applications.

12. Hence following interim order is passed :-

- (A)
- (i) State Government shall be free and shall carry out the process of scrutiny of credentials / documents of eligibility of all candidates who are selected by M.P.S.C. for holding interviews in the recruitment subject matter.
 - (ii) Applicants in the Original Applications and selected candidates shall be free to point out deficiencies in eligibility of various candidates within their knowledge, within 10 days from today.
 - (iii) The lists of the candidates whose eligibility is found, prima facie, deficient with reference to Recruitment Rules or Advertisement, with list of deficiencies be published in P.D.F. format on official web-site of Government of Maharashtra and individual intimation of flashing on web-site be sent on e-mail address to all the candidates.
 - (iv) All the candidates whose eligibility is questioned shall be given a fair opportunity to tender evidence as regards own eligibility, by fixing a date for counseling.

D. —

- (v) Candidates be given opportunity to present their point of view or defence against any point of deficiency produce evidence etc. as regards eligibility vis-a-vis the Recruitment Rules and / or the Advertisement.
- (vi) The programme of scrutiny be announced.
- (vii) Final lists be prepared by segregating the eligible or not eligible candidates, and it be published / intimated and be produced on next date of hearing.
- (B) Interim order shall continue till final hearing.
- (C) Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed to learned P.O..
- (D) Learned P.O. is directed to communicate this order to the Respondents.
- (E) Hearing is adjourned to 26.07.2018.

ORDER

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. **Admitted facts of the case are as under :-**
 - (a) The Applicant is working on the post of Junior Clerk in the office of Assistant Commissioner of Social Welfare, Pune from 31/12/2014.
 - (b) Vide the impugned order at page no.35, Annexure 'A9', the Applicant K. D. Ebhate is transferred to Social Welfare Office at Jalna on administrative grounds.
 - (c) As per the Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005, Section 3 - Tenure of posting reads as under:-

"Provided that, when such employee is from the non-secretariat services, in Group C, such employee shall be transferred from the post held, on his completion of two full tenures at that office or department, to another office or Department."
 - (d) Annexure 'A4', page no.18 to 22 is the G.R. regarding precautions to be taken while affecting the transfer.

3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that the impugned order is in violation of Section 3 of the Transfer Act. It also violates the procedure mentioned under Section 4 (4) and 4(5) as under:-

"Section 4(4): The transfers of Government servants shall ordinarily be made only once in a year in the month of April or May:

Provided that, transfer may be made any time in the year in the circumstances as specified below, namely :-

- (i) To the newly created post or to the posts which become vacant due to retirement, promotion, resignation, reversion, reinstatement, consequential vacancy on account of transfer or on return from leave;*
- (ii) Where the competent authority is satisfied that the transfer is essential due to exceptional circumstances or special reasons, after recording the same in writing and with the prior approval of the next higher authority.*

Section 4(5): Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 3 or this section, the competent authority may, in special cases, after recording reasons in writing and with the prior (approval of the immediately superior) Transferring Authority mentioned in the table of section 6, transfer a Government servant before completion of his tenure of post."

4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that there is no adherence to above mentioned provisions. She cites the judgment of this Tribunal in O.A. No.889 & 890 of 2015, dated 16.06.2016. Para No.10 of O.A.Nos.889 & 890/2015 is as under:-

"10. The impugned order dated 30.05.2015 is purportedly passed under the provision of section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act. As the order was passed in the month of May (i.e. on 30.05.2015), there was no need to invoke section 4(4)(ii). However, invoking section 4(5) clearly shows that the Applicant had not completed their tenures. As per section 4(5) of the Transfer Act, such transfers can be made with the prior approval of the 'immediately superior Transferring Authority' mentioned in the table of Section 6, in special cases. Admittedly, the 'Transferring Authority' as per section 6 of the Transfer Act is 'Minister-in-charge in consultation with Secretaries of the concerned Departments'. Second proviso to section 6 reads:-

"Provided further that the Competent Transferring Authority specified in the table may be general or special order, delegates its power under this section to any of the subordinate authority".

Section 6 deals with Transferring Authority and powers to transfer employees of various categories to be exercised by such authorities. This section does not deal with transfer envisaged in section 4 of the Transfer Act, which are so to say extraordinary powers. The terms used in section 4 and 'next higher authority' and 'immediately superior Transferring Authority'. Prior approval of these authorities in writing is required in exceptional circumstances or for special reasons. However, after prior approval is given, the order issued by the Transferring Authority will be valid. Second proviso to section 6 permits delegation of powers under that section only. It cannot be enlarged to include delegation of powers of authorities mentioned in section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5), who are not the Transferring Authorities. Learned Counsel for the Applicant contended that section 4 of the Transfer act deals with cases, where extraordinary powers are being exercised and if such powers are delegated to lower level functionaries, the very purpose of enacting the Transfer Act would be defeated. I agree with his contention fully. The law does not provide for delegation of powers of the authorities under section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Act and transfer under these sections will have to be with the approval of original authorities mentioned in Table of Section 6, and not by the authorities to whom powers have been delegated, as was done by circular dated 05.12.2014. The impugned order has not been issued with the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister as required under section 4(5) of the Transfer Act and is unsustainable."

5. Learned Advocate for the Applicant further mentions that there were complaints against the Applicant. Even then she states that such person should be transferred only after enquiring into the complaints as mentioned in Para 8 of the G.R. dated 11.02.2015 (Page No.21). Therefore, she prays that the impugned order being legal should be quashed and set aside.
6. Learned Advocate for the Applicant further prays that interim order which has been issued earlier on 31.05.2017 may be made absolute.
7. Learned P.O. for the Respondents seeks adjournment for one week to further her arguments.
8. S.O. to 05.07.2018, as a Part-Heard.

ORDER

1. Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned advocate for the Applicant, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents and Ms. B.N. Punalekar, the learned Advocate holding for Shri N.P. Dalvi, the learned Advocate for the M.P.S.C.
2. The interim relief order is granted by this Tribunal in various cases which has arisen out of the recruitment process in relation to Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector.
3. It is not any dispute that interim relief order is granted in O.A.No.425 of 2018. Hence same interim relief order.
4. Heard on interim relief.
5. It is urged that stand of the Government is already ruled against the Government and now Government has carried the issue before Hon'ble Supreme Court and order of status quo is granted.

6. In this peculiar situation, let the Applicant be permitted to participate in the process of verification of documents for selection to the post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector and result be kept in sealed cover.

7. One post be kept vacant for accommodating the applicant in the event she succeeds.

8. Respondents shall have liberty to move for modification of Interim relief if there is change in legal position after filing reply.
