2. In the present O.A., the Applicant has challenged the impugned order dated 26.03.2019 issued by District Treasury, Satara addressed to office of A.G. Mumbai for stoppage of pension of the Applicant with immediate effect. The Applicant stands retired in 2014 and all the service benefits were extended to him. He was getting regular pension till impugned order.
3. The issue seems relating to absorption and regularization in service. In O.A. No.97S/2018 filed by Shri Balasaheb Lambhate in similar situation a communication for stoppage of pension was challenged. The Applicant appears to be similarly situated person. O.A. No.97S/2018 is decided on merit on 16.04.2019. It appears that prima-facie the Applicant's case is governed by the decision rendered by this Tribunal in O.A.No.97S/2018.
4. In view of above, it is necessary to know about the finality of the judgment in O.A. No.97S/2018. Respondent Nos.1 and 2 are, therefore, required to make their stand clear.
5. Respondent Nos.1 and 2 are, therefore, directed to clarify as to why the benefit of the judgment in O.A.No.97S/2018 can't be extended to the present Applicant and shall apprise the Tribunal about the steps taken by them in respect of implementation of the directions given by this Tribunal in O.A.No.97S/2018.
6. Learned P.O. is directed to apprise the Respondent Nos.1 and 2 about the observations made by the Tribunal as above and to take instructions so that this O.A. could be disposed of expeditiously. The issue of interim relief will be considered on next date.

2. The Applicant has filed the present O.A. seeking directions for reconstruction of service book and for grant of retiral benefits which are not paid to him. The Applicant stands retired on 31.07.2016 but did not get retiral benefits because of destruction of service book in the fire broke out in Mantralaya in 2012. After filing of the O.A., the Tribunal has passed various orders from time to time asking the Respondents to take steps for reconstruction of service book and to process the pension papers of the Applicant. In pursuance of the said directions, the service book has been reconstructed and the matter for grant of regular pension is in process.
3. Today, learned P.O. on instructions from Smt. Pranali Gosavi-Yadav, Desk Officer, Revenue and Forest Dept. submitted that the department has granted provision pension because of delay and soon after verification of service book from Pay Verification Unit, the regular pension will be released as per his entitlement. She further submitted that there is some recovery against the Applicant for which necessary steps will be taken by the department.
4. In view of above, the present O.A. can be disposed of with suitable directions as the service book is already reconstructed and the matter for grant of regular pension and other benefits is in process.
5. For the aforesaid reasons, O.A. is disposed of with direction to the Respondents to get all formalities done about updating of service book and to pass appropriate orders about the pension and other dues of the Applicant as per his entitlement in accordance to law within one month from today.
6. If the Applicant felt aggrieved by the orders of pension or other benefits, he may avail recourse of law as may be permissible to him.
7. No order as to costs.
