The learned CPO mentions that in pursuance to our directions in OA No.629/2024, dated 10.05.2024; Shri Sunil Hanje, Deputy Secretary (Sports) School Education & Sports Department and Shri Sudhir More, Joint Director (Sports), Pune are present as the Tribunal wanted their assistance in respect of 4 Games i.e (a) Ice-Hockey, (b) Soft Tennis, (c) Karate and (d) Sepaktakraw.</p> <p>3. The learned CPO then on instructions and after discussion with the above officers informs that in so far as 3 Games of (i) Sepaktakraw, (ii) Karate and (iii) Soft Tennis are concerned, the State Government will take Policy Decision about 'Affiliation' and 'Recognition' of the 'Association' of these '3 Games' as it is under active consideration of the State Government. As State Government is expected to take appropriate decision within 'Two Weeks'; therefore O.A.Nos.635/2024,</p>

4. The learned CPO further submits that in respect of 'Ice-Hockey' which is played by Applicants in O.A.No.619/2024 and O.A.No.620/2024; State Government has serious doubt and reservations about genuineness of 'Sports Certificates'. Hence, learned CPO seeks more time to take further instructions from State Government in matters relating to 'Sports Certificates' given for 'Ice-Hockey'.

5. The learned CPO thereupon submits that another grievance made by present Applicants in all these OAs is that as per guidelines of GR dated 30.06.2022 it was expected from the Respondent Nos.2 to 5 to pass Order within 15 days from the date of receipt of proposal of 'Re-verification' of 'Sport Certificates' of Applicants. As per the rules, the order of 'Re-verification' of 'Sports Certificate' should be 'Reasoned Order' and it should contain 'Time Limit' for challenge in Appeal. She further states that Applicants at the time of 'Re-verification' of 'Sports Certificate' are not heard. Thus, if School Education and Sports Department and Director of Sports, Pune are serious doubt about validity of Sports Certificates of any Candidate or 'Verification Report' or 'Reverification of Sports Certificate' given to any Candidate; then it is always desirable to give audience to concerned Candidates and then pass 'Reasoned Order'. The School Education and Sports Department can do so hereinafter. However, the above observations be considered for inclusion as 'Policy Decision' by School Education and Sports Department

6. The O.A. No.619/2024 and O.A.No.620/2024 are accordingly adjourned to 11.07.2024.
