- 1. Heard Smt. A.B. Kololgi, learned P.O. for Applicants (Ori. Respondents) and Ms. S.H. Badlani, learned Advocate for Respondent (Ori. Applicant).
- 2. This M.A. is filed for condonation of delay caused in filing R.A. in respect of order passed by the Tribunal on 01.12.2020 in O.A.No.666/2019.
- 3. Indeed, in view of order of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 10.01.2022, the present R.A. will have to be held within limitation. Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition No.03/2020 passed specific order thereby giving more time to file judicial proceedings considering Covid-19 Pandemic situation and lockdown. In Clause No.(iii) of the order, it is held as under:-

"(iii) In cases where the limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022, notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022. In the event the actual balance period of limitation remaining, with effect from 01.03.2022 is greater than 90 days, that longer period shall apply."

- 4. Now turning to the facts of the present case, O.A. was decided on 01.12.2020 and R.A. was to be filed on or before 01.01.2021. Thus, limitation expired on 01.01.2021 which is during the period from 15.03.2020 to 28.02.2022. As per the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court. Therefore, any proceedings were required to be filed within the limitation of 90 days from 01.03.2022. Whereas present O.A. is filed on 29.03.2022. This being the position, the delay has to be condoned.
