Learned PO states that the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai on 04.10.2023 has already issued orders to relieve total of 130 Police Constables which includes 68 Male Constables and 62 Female Constables on 'Inter District Transfer'. While doing so, the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai has considered the criteria of 'Length of Service' which is (i) 20 Years for Male Constables and (ii) 10 years for Female Constables but did not consider their 'Dates of Applications' of these 68 Male Constables and 62 Female Constables.</p> <p align="right">[P.T.O.]</p>

	<p>3. Learned Advocates for the Applicants state that the criteria of 'Length of Service' used by the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai to relieve the 68 Male Constables and 62 Female Constables with few exceptions does injustice to many other Police Constables who have lesser 'Length of Service' but for more compelling 'Personal Reasons' had applied much earlier to the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai and must be considered forthwith and relieved to join the establishments of either (i) Commissioner of Police and (ii) District Superintendent of Police.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocates for the Applicants further stated that as per guidelines in Home Department G.R. dated 26.10.2017, it is necessary to consider the 'Dates of Application' and not just the 'Length of Service' of the Police Constables seeking Inter District Transfers from the establishment of Commissioner of Police, Mumbai.</p> <p>5. The guidelines of Home Department GR of 26.10.2017 require the decision on applications of Inter District Transfers to be taken promptly within one month based on recommendation of PEB by respective Commissioner of Police and Superintendent of Police. Therefore, the inference is that respective Commissioner of Police and Superintendent of Police would have to go by the 'Dates of Applications' and not the 'Length of Service' for which qualifying criteria is 'Minimum Service' of 8 years in all 'General Cases' and 3 years in 'Special Cases'. Therefore, if the 'Dates of Application' is to be the criteria, then naturally Police Constables with various 'Lengths of Service' come into the 'Zone of Consideration'. Thus for the establishment of Commissioner of Police, Mumbai in the aforesaid context, the data based on the 'Dates of Application' of 'Police Constable' will have to be compiled for each 'Administrative Year' in 'Ascending Order' to get better assessment of the number of 'Police Constables' who can be considered to be relieved for 'Inter District Transfers'. However, as compilation of this data will take some time, thus in the meanwhile in order to consider how 'Dates of Application' as is inferred from Home Department GR dated 26.10.2017 can be factored in to reduce the high pendency of the 'Inter District Transfers' on the establishment of Commissioner of Police, Mumbai, it is imperative to</p>


