- The applicants who are working in Zilla Parishad Departmental Primary School have appeared for Competitive Examination of 2017 for the post of Deputy Education Officer, Group B, which was held on 13.8.2017 as per advertisement No.40/17. The cut-off mark was 150. All the 6 applicants have secured more than 150 marks. However, they were not called for interview. The State has refused to call them for interview because they being Primary Teachers, the recruitment rules for the post of Deputy Education Officer, Group B are not applicable to them and they cannot be considered as feeder cadre.
- Earlier OA No.634 of 2017 (Shrikant D. Sutar & 10 Ors. Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors.) was decided by this Tribunal on 4.10.2018. Similar issue was agitated by those applicants, who were also similarly situated being Primary Teachers like the present applicants. The said OA was decided in favour of those applicants and they were declared to be eligible to apply along with Primary Teachers for the post advertised through advertisement No.40/17. Therefore, the present applicants have also approached this Tribunal by filing the present OA.
- Ld. PO submits that by order dated 9.4.2019 in speaking to minutes of the order dated 4.10.2018, the words, "Primary Teachers who are serving in employment of Government of Maharashtra and" were deleted and words "The Applicants" were added in Clause (B) of para 35 of the order dated 4.10.2018. Ld. PO therefore submits that the present applicants cannot be covered under the said order as it is specially mentioned by way of speaking to minutes and

the Tribunal has restricted the order in persona and hence the order is not applicable in rem.
