2. When the matter is taken up for hearing it is notice that the Applicant's services are absorbed in terms of Maharashtra Medical & Health Services Group -A (One time Absorption of Medical Officers working on ad-hoc basis in Maharashtra) (Special) Rules, 2009. The Applicant has made representation for counting Ad-hoc services for all consequential benefits but the same is not responded. Hence, present O.A. is filed.

3. Thus, apparently the Applicant's services are absorbed in terms of Rules 2009 which *inter-alia* specifically provides that services rendered by the ad-hoc Medical Officers prior to the date of absorption shall not be considered for pay, pension, leave and grant of promotion as a specialist or any other post under the Assured Career Progression Scheme (Rules 4 (vii)) Rules, 2009. However, there is no challenge to the Rules which are framed by the Government in Article 309 of Constitution of India.

4. When specific query was raised to learned Advocate for the Applicant that how the Applicant is entitled for benefits of Ad-hoc services in view of Rules, 2009. She submits that she will challenge the legality of Rules, 2009 and will amend O.A. In case there is challenge to validity of Rules matter will be required to be placed before Division Bench.

5. On request of learned Advocate for the Applicant two weeks time is granted to take necessary steps.


