- 1. Heard Shri Arvind V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant who is working as State Excise Inspector, Flying Squad, Nashik has challenged suspension order dated 24.06.2021, whereby he seems to be suspended invoking Rules 4(1)(a) of M.C.S. of (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, 1979. The Applicant Headquarter is kept at Nandurbar.
- 3. Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant sought interim relief in the form of stay to the suspension order as well as for change of Headquarter, since in terms of circular dated 19.03.2021, Headquarter should be placed where the Government servant is posted at the time of suspension.
- 4. Perusal of suspension order reveals that *prima-facie* the Applicant has been suspended because of his failure to detect spurious liquor as a Member of flying squad. As per suspension order on 09.06.2021 State Level Flying Squad laid raid at village Mouje Ajande (Kh), Tal. Shirpur, Dist. Dule and seized spurious liquor and other goods worth Rs.84,39,089/- (Eighty Four Lakhs Thirty Nine Thousand and Eighty Nine only). Thus *prima-facie* there was material for suspension of the Applicant. Therefore, I am not inclined to grant stay to the suspension order dated 24.06.2021.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. However, in so far as change of Headquarter is concerned, in view of circular referred above, in case of suspension Headquarter of Government servant should be in the place of his last posting.
- 6. Learned P.O. submits that she will take instructions from Respondent in this regard as to how Headquarter is kept at Nandurbar instead of Nashik.
- 7. In view of above, Respondent Commissioner of Police State Excise is directed to take remedial measures in respect of Headquarter and may pass appropriate order within a week.

- 4. Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate submits that Respondents will interpret operative order to the disadvantage of the Applicants, and therefore, it is necessary to substitute Clause 'B' of operative order by another operative order as reproduced above.
- 5. In first place, his apprehension is misplaced and based only on assumption.
- 6. The dispute was about the applicability of GRs dated 21.10.1995 or 22.10.1996 or 10.03.2005.
- 7. Learned Advocate for the Applicant sought to exclude GR dated 10.03.2005 from operative order.
- 8. The Tribunal has already recorded its observation and finding particularly in para. 10,16,20 & 24, and therefore, the authorities will have to consider not only operative order but findings recorded by the Tribunal.
- 9. Tribunal held that the Applicants are entitled to service benefits including retrial benefits as per G.R. dated 21.10.1995, 22.10.1996 and 10.03.2005, whichever is applicable, provided that they have completed 10 years service on out of date mentioned in concerned GR. As such there is no ambiguity in operative order and there is no question of exclusion of G.R. dated 10.03.2005 from operative order. Operative order will have to be read in the light of findings recorded in para 10,16,20 & 24 of the order
- 10. M.A. therefore needs no further clarification and therefore disposed of.
