- 1. Heard Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Applicant (Org. Respondent) and Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Respondent (Org. Applicant).
- 2. M.A. No.552/2022 is filed for condonation of delay caused in filing M.A. No.553/2022 which is filed for recalling the order dated 13.07.2022 passed in O.A. No.665/2022.



- 3. The Applicant had filed O.A. No.665/2022 to quash and set aside order dated 22.03.2022 issued by Respondents whereby recovery of Rs.2,50,243/-(Two Lakhs Fifty Thousand Two Hundred and Forty Three Only) sought from his retiral benefits. The Applicant stand retired on 31.08.2021. He is group 'C' employee. It is only after retirement by impugned order dated 22.03.2022 recovery has been sought and his pay has been downgraded.
- 4. O.A. was taken up for admission on 11.07.2022, on that day it was noticed that recovery *prima-facie* is impermissible in view of decision by Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2015) 4 SCC 334 (State of Punjab and others Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer). Learned P.O. also made fair submission that if challenge is to the extent of recovery only, in that event Tribunal may dispose of O.A. in view of judgment of Rafiq Masih's case (cited supra). Learned Advocate for the Applicant however sought two days time to take instruction from the Applicant as to whether challenge is restricted to recovery, matter was accordingly adjourned to 13.07.2022.
- 5. On 13.07.2022 when the matter was taken up for hearing at the stage of admission, learned Advocate for the Applicant made categorical statement that the challenge is restricted to the excess payment only and he is not challenging re-fixation of pay. That apart, learned P.O. also fairly concedes legal position in view of decision in *Rafiq Masih's case (cited supra)*. The Tribunal recorded the submission advanced by the learned counsel and passed the order thereby setting aside recovery order dated 22.03.2022 to the extent of recovery in view of the Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Rafiq Masih's case (cited supra)*. In Para 7, 8, & 9 Tribunal recorded the submission advanced by learned P.O. which is as under:-
 - "7. Learned P.O. also fairly concedes the legal position that recovery is not permissible. Indeed, Special Inspector General of Police by order dated 05.09.2018 (22 of P.B.) has already given direction to all the Department working under him that in view of decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Rafiq Masih's case (cited*

M.A.552/22 in M.A.553/22 in O.A.665 of 2022

supra) there should not be recovery of excess payment. Despite this position by impugned order dated 22.03.2022 recovery is sought. In this view of the matter, O.A. deserves to be allowed partly.

3

8. Impugned order dated 22.03.2022 is quashed and set aside to the extent of recovery only.

9. Since, the Applicant's retiral benefits are withheld for long time, Respondent is directed to release all his retiral benefits as per his entitlement within one month from today."

6. It is thus manifest that the legal position was fairly conceded and

after hearing learned P.O. matter was disposed.

7. Now these M.As are filed to recall the order *inter-alia* on the ground that the Applicant had given undertaking on 13.05.2009 that he

would return excess amount and requested the Tribunal to recall the

order dated 13.07.2022 so as to facilitate to file Affidavit-in-Reply and

then to decide O.A. on merit. Indeed, no such undertaking dated

13.05.2009 is Annexed to M.A. Be that as it may, this could not be the

ground to recall the order in this manner.

8. Admittedly, the Applicant retired as group 'C' employee and

recovery is sought after retirement. O.A. was allowed after hearing

- 2. In this Contempt Application the Respondent-State was expected to comply with the order of the Tribunal dated 2.3.2022 wherein the Tribunal directed to fix the responsibility for delayed payment of retirement benefits to the applicant such as payment of gratuity, leave encashment, GIS and commutation of pension. It was further directed to fix the responsibility and the applicant should be paid the interest at the approved rate for the delayed payment within a period of four weeks.
- 3. The applicant retired on 28.2.2011. The applicant was given full Provisional Pension from March, 2011 to February 2012. Thereafter, he was given regular pension and other retirement dues from 6.12.2013. Learned C.P.O submits that whatever gap was there of 1 ½ years the interest was paid to the applicant. The persons who were found responsible for the delay, notice was given to them and the Respondent-State has taken action against them. Learned C.P.O submits that the order of this Tribunal has been complied with.
- 4. Learned counsel submits that there is dispute on the interest on commutation of pension.
- 5. We verified the fact from both the counsel. It reveals that the applicant was given the full Provisional Pension from 6.12.2013. He applied for 30% commutation of pension in the year 2014. However, the said application was not decided and his 30% pension was commuted on 16.10.2019.
- 6. Under such circumstances, when the applicant was paid full provisional pension, there is no question of paying interest on the commuted amount of pension. 30% amount of pension was commuted from 2019. Hence the order of this Tribunal has been complied with.
