2. It is the grievance of the applicant that within three months of his posting at Latur, vide the impugned order he has been transferred to Nanded allegedly on administrative grounds. The aforesaid order is challenged by the applicant in the present Original Application. The applicant is presently working on the post of Police Inspector. Vide order dated 3.2.2023 he was transferred from Police Station Udgir City to MIDC Police Station, Latur. The applicant accordingly resumed duties at transferred place. While he was discharging duties on the said post, he has been again transferred to Nanded vide the impugned order of transfer dated 27.06.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the applicant has been transferred contrary to the transfer guidelines and the rules in regard to the transfer of the Police Personnel as provided under Section 22N of

the Maharashtra Police Act. Learned counsel submitted that in the ordinary course, applicant was entitled to be at the transferred place for 2 years. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant would be retiring in the month of March, 2024 on attaining the age of superannuation. Learned counsel submitted that on 06.03.2024, the applicant would attain the age of superannuation and thus, he will be retiring by the end of the said month i.e. on 31.03.2024. Learned counsel submitted that in such circumstances, issuance of impugned transfer order, that too from one district to another district has caused serious prejudice and harassment to the applicant. The applicant in O.A. has therefore, prayed for quashment of the impugned order.

4. The respondents have filed their affidavit in reply, thereby opposing the contentions raised and the prayers made in the Original Application. The only ground which seems to have been pressed in the affidavit in reply is that the applicant was due for his transfer from Latur since he had spent the maximum period in the said region.

5. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, respondents. It is not in dispute that much before the issuance of the order of

transfer the applicant on 4.4.2023 had made a representation to respondent No. 2 praying for his retention at the existing place on the ground that he was to retire on 31.3.2024 on attaining the age of superannuation. In the said representation the applicant has particularly stated that he has to build his house and if he is transferred at some another district it will be very inconvenient for him to supervise the construction of his house. The applicant has also stated in his said representation that at the time of annual inspection of his Police Station, respondent No. 2 has assured him that he would not be transferred. It however, appears that ignoring the representation so made by the applicant he has been transferred to another district on the verge of retirement. The respondent has referred to and replied upon rule 6(C)(1)(c) of the amended rules of 2015. True it is that the aforesaid rule provides the maximum period for one officer to retain in the particular region. Rules are to be given purposive interpretation. It has to be further stated that though there may not be any such provision in the Maharashtra Police Act, at least it is not brought to my notice which provides for retention of the Government servant, who is at verge of retirement at his existing place or to give him the posting of his choice near to his native place, if such request is

made by him, but such provision is certainly there in the Maharashtra Civil Services Rules. Rule 5 (1) (a) of the Transfer Act, provides that the employee due for transfer after completion of tenure at a station of posting or post, if he has less than one year for his retirement he can be retained at the existing place on his request till the date of his retirement. Such provision can very well be invoked in the present matter.

6. In the affidavit in reply nothing adverse has been said against the applicant. The interim relief was granted in favour of the applicant vide order passed by this Tribunal on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2023, thereby directing the respondents to allow the applicant to discharge his duties on his existing post. Having regard to the fact that only few months are remaining for retirement of the applicant on his attaining the age of superannuation, the request of the applicant for his retention at the existing place deserves to be considered. It may be in all respect impracticable and unjust also to ask the applicant to resume duties at the transferred place. Taking into account the fact that the Government servant has to discharge several obligations before his retirement a specific provision has been made in the Transfer Act, 2005, which enables the retention of the Government servant at the existing place, when the period of less

than one year has remained for his retirement. Present is the fit case, wherein such discretion can be exercised.

7. For the reasons stated above the following order is passed: -

(i) Order dated 27.6.2023 is quashed and set aside.

(ii) Respondents are directed to retain the applicant at his existing place till his retirement i.e.
31<sup>st</sup> March, 2024.
