ORDER

1. Pursuant to the order dated 19.09.2024 passed by this Tribunal wherein it was directed to learned P.O. to make responsible statement in respect of the representation dated 13.09.2024 made by the Applicant and also it was expected that somebody from the office of Respondent to remain present and make statement about giving choice posting to the Applicant with regard to his representation dated 13.09.2024.

2. However, today learned P.O. Mr. Chougule has submitted as follows :

(a) <u>Submissions of learned P.O.</u> : Applicant did not give representation with his choice when he was transferred by order dated 31.08.2024.

<u>Findings of the Tribunal</u> : These submissions are baseless as to how the applicant would be aware that he was going to be transferred.

(b) <u>Submissions of learned P.O.</u>: How the Department will come to know the difficulties of the Government servants.

<u>Findings of the Tribunal</u> : It is difficult to understand the expectation of the Department that when the applicant was not transferred for seven years from the Tribal area where he was working, how the Government 2

servant will know the mind of the Government as to why by which order or in which year he is going to be transferred. I highlight Clause 2(क) of G.R. dated 11.08.2000 and it is reproduced for ready reference

"क) वरीलप्रमाणे पसंतीच्या जिल्हयांत बदली मिळण्यसाठी, आदिवासी क्षेत्रात काम करणा-या अधिकारी/कर्मचारी यांनी उपरोक्त विहित कार्यकाळ संपण्यापूर्वी किमान ३ महिने आधी त्यांच्या पसंतीच्या जिल्हयांची तीन नावे सक्षम प्राधिका-यांना कळवावीत व त्याची प्रत तो कार्यरत असलेल्या क्षेत्राच्या जिल्हाधिकारी / विभागीय आयुक्त यांना देण्यात यावी."

(c) <u>Submissions of learned P.O.</u>: There is on special provision in the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred as 'ROTA 2005' for brevity) to consider the difficulties of disabled persons.

Findings of the Tribunal : The attention of Additional Chief Secretary of Public Health Department is drawn on Government Circular dated 15.04.2004 issued by the G.A.D. of reiterating that the Departments are not implementing the provisions of 'the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' (hereinafter referred as 'Disabilities Act, 2016' for brevity), though time to time instructions were given while passed in transfer orders. The relevant portion of Government Circular dated 15.04.2004 is quoted below :

"शासकीय सेवेतील अपंग कर्मचाऱ्यांच्या बदल्या सहानुभूतीचा दृष्टीकोन ठेऊन त्यांच्या राहत्या ठिकाणाजवळ करण्याबाबत संदर्भाधीन परिपत्रकान्यये सूचना देण्यात आल्या होत्या. तथापि या सूचनांची व्यवस्थित अंमलबजावणी होत नाही असे निदर्शनास आल्यामुळे या परिपत्रकान्वये मंत्रालयीन विभाग व त्यांच्या नियंत्राणाखालील विभाग प्रमुख / कार्यालय प्रमुख यांना पुन्हा सूचना देण्यात येत आहेत की, शासकीय कर्मचाऱ्यांच्या बदल्यांचे विनियमन करण्यासाठी शासनाने दिनांक १६ जानेवारी २००४ रोजी प्रख्यापित केलेल्या अध्यादेशास अधीन राहून शासकीय सेवेतील अपंग कर्मचाऱ्यांच्या बदल्या प्रशासकीय सोयीनुसार शक्य असल्यास त्यांच्या राहत्या ठिकाणाजवळ कराव्यात."

(d) <u>Submissions of learned P.O.</u>: While pointing out the G.R. dated 14.07.2021 and on instructions from Mr. Vasant Gaikwad, Under Secretary who is present learned P.O. has submitted that only at the time of direct recruits and promotions the difficulties of the disabled persons can be considered. He has further submitted that there are no provisions to give any concessions to disabled persons at the time of transfer. He has submitted that now the Applicant's representation

dated 13.09.2024 is received by the Department and after considering the vacancy position the Department will consider the case of the Applicant.

Findings of the Tribunal : The submissions made by learned P.O. are shocking as it displace the insensitivity of the State towards disabled persons, especially, on the background of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 and amended Act of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, Act, 2016. It appears that the provisions and directions given in the Act and G.Rs. and so also Government Circulars are not understood by the concern Department.

3. In view of above, I direct the Additional Chief Secretary, Mr. Milind Mhaiskar to look into this matter and pass order after going through this order dated 20.09.2024 and yesterday's order dated 19.09.2024.

4. Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar wants to correct his earlier submissions which he made in order dated 19.09.2024 and Applicant is suffering from 76% disability in his left leg and not right leg.

5. Adjourned to 24.09.2024.
