2. By this C.A. applicant prays for implementation of judgment / order dated 17.08.2015 passed in O.A.Nos.142, 143 & 144/2015 filed by Dr. Shreekant Shankarrao Deshpande Versus The State of Maharashtra & Ors. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that the applicant who is Medical Officer, by profession, in O.A. was allowed to work till the age of 64 years and not 62 years. He has relied on the judgment/ order dated 25.09.2003 passed by the M.A.T. Bench Aurangabad in T.A.No.2262/1991 (Writ Petition No.879/1990).

3. Learned P.O. has submitted that there is no such order allowing the applicant to work till 64 years. She relied on the order dated 16.10.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition No.165/2016 filed by the State of Maharashtra against the applicant challenging the said order dated 17.08.2015. She also relied on G.R. dated 03.09.2021, wherein it is mentioned that the applicant was given benefit of continuity in service from the age of 58 to 62 years.

4. We have gone through these judgment and especially order/ judgment dated 17.08.2015 passed in O.A.Nos.142, 143 & 144/2015 wherein the applicant was allowed to work till 64 years of age. But however he was allowed to continue to work till he attained the age of 62 years.

5. In view of above, C.A. stands dismissed.




3. In view of the above hearing of OA is expedited.

5. Perused the said order dated 24.6.2022. The present applicant is a Naib Tahsildar and challenges his placement in the seniority list which was also subject matter of OA No.480 of 2020. In OA the applicant in para 10(a) has also referred to judgment and order dated 29.10.2010 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.5059 of 2010 (Mr. K.K. Bhadane) as well as judgments in different OAs viz. No.182/2009, 18/2009, 187/2009, 34/2020, 310/2011 & 629/2015.

6. The issues in the present OA are similar and identical as in OA No.480/2020. Hence, we allow this OA with following directions:

(a) The applicant's case is to be decided from the date of joining i.e. 25.8.2010 with all consequential benefits.

(b) Applicant is to be placed at Sr. No.764 in the seniority list.

(c) The respondents are directed to complete the exercise within three months i.e. on or before 13.1.2023.

The applicant belongs to reserved category however his caste certificate was invalidated. He has put in service till superannuation. He has relied on the judgment and order dated 23.3.2022 passed by the Nagpur Bench of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.547 of 2021 (Namdeo D. Nikhare Vs. Secretary, PWD & Ors.). Ld. Advocate submits that petitioner in W.P. failed to submit the caste certificate. Though his caste claim was invalidated he was not put in supernumerary post and therefore after his superannuation, as per order of the Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur Bench such civil servant is entitled to pensionary benefits in accordance with law. Ld. Advocate submits that applicant's case is identical and therefore he is to be given pensionary benefits. Applicant sought appointment on 22.9.1981 from ST category but claim was invalidated. He was not put on supernumerary post and retired on 30.6.2022 after attaining superannuation. Hence, she prays that applicant is to be given pensionary benefits. Ld. Advocate submits that similar view is taken by this Tribunal in OA No.476/2022 decided on 11.10.2022 (Dr. Anant M. Kadhikhye Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors.)</p> <p>3. Ld. PO submits that reply is filed on 30.9.2022 by Shri Ram Shankar Dhotre, Divisional Forest Officer, Pune. Ld. PO submits that applicant has filed W.P. No.1256 of 2003 regarding his caste validity and the W.P. was dismissed. The applicant continued to work by way of interim relief as Administrative Officer, Class-I. As per GR dated 21.12.2019, the Government employees whose caste certificates are invalidated, they are transferred to supernumerary post. Applicant's proposal was sent by</p>

4. We have considered submissions of both the sides. It was necessary on the part of respondent-State to put the applicant on supernumerary post. However, it was not done for more than one year; till the date of superannuation of the applicant. Pendency of the proposal is not a ground to deny the pensionary benefits to the applicant.

5. MA for expediting the hearing of OA is allowed.

6. In view of this, we allow the claim of the applicant for pensionary benefits especially in view of the judgment and order dated 23.3.2022 passed by the Nagpur Bench of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.547 of 2021 (Namdeo D. Nikhare Vs. Secretary, PWD & Ors.).

7. OA is allowed. The respondents are directed to release the retiral benefits of the applicant within three months i.e. on or before 14.1.2023. OA and MA are disposed off accordingly.
