Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that the Applicant who is a Police Inspector on the establishment of the 'Commissioner of Police, Mumbai' had submitted his Application on 04.01.2023 in response to letter of 'D.I.G., C.B.I., Spl. Unit, Mumbai to the 'Commissioner of Police, Mumbai' dated 09.12.2022 regarding "Induction of Police Inspectors on Deputation Basis'. Subsequently, establishment of the 'Commissioner of Police, Mumbai' also issued 'Notice No.0004' dated 05.01.2023 relating to the 'Induction of Police Inspectors in CBI, SU Mumbai on Deputation Basis'.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that he has been selected for and accordingly it has been conveyed by 'D.I.G., C.B.I., Spl. Unit, Mumbai' to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' by letter dated 14.09.2023. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that the 'Place of Posting' of the Applicant in this letter of 14.09.2023 of D.I.G., C.B.I., Spl. Unit, Mumbai' has been shown as 'CBI, BSFB, Mumbai, 11th Floor, C-35A, G Block, B.K.C, Mumbai 400 098'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant then states that as per 'Office Order' published by 'Police Notice' in 'Part 3' on 18.10.2023 at 'Sr. No.163 mentions that the Applicant was relieved on 13.10.2023 to Join to 'C.B.I. H.Q.' at Delhi and subsequently by modified order dated 18.10.2023 stands relieved to join 'Government of Manipur'.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. Learned Advocate for the Applicant further states that the consent of the Applicant was specifically in respect to the contents of letter of D.I.G., C.B.I., Spl. Unit, Mumbai dated 09.12.2022 addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai and subsequent Notice No.0004/2023 of the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai dated 05.01.2023.
- that though the Applicant had submitted Application for "Induction of Police Inspectors on Deputation Basis' and he has since been selected by the 'Director, C.B.I.' at the time of him being relieved from the establishment of the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai, he will be subject to the provisions of Rule 36, of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules, 1981. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that thereupon even Applicant has since sought to withdraw his consent by submitting letter dated 26.09.2023 to the office of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.
- 7. Learned P.O. presents 'Summary of Correspondence' from the Director and Under Secretary in Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India to the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra dated 16.08.2023, 22.08.2023, 11.09.2023 & 18.09.2023 all of which relate to "Induction of Police Inspectors on Deputation Basis'.
- The letters of Under Secretary, Ministry of Home 8. Affairs dated 16.08.2023 addressed to the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra mentions that "For the purpose of ensuring the proper investigation of the FIRs which have been transferred to the CBI, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed to place the services of 01 Inspector level officer from Maharashtra. The officer shall be on deputation to CBI and shall perform his functions under the overall structure the CBI. He will submit periodic information and reports as may be required by Shri Dattatray Padsalgikar, the officer appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to supervise the investigation. The office shall abide by the direction as may be issued in that regard by him from time to time. In view of the above directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Government of Maharashtra is requested to kindly depute 01 Inspector level Officer, in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, for disposal of their services to CBI within 05 days." Hence the string of the correspondence as above from Director and Under

Secretary from the Ministry of Home Affairs and Government of India to the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra and further communication in this regard from the office of 'D.G.P. — Maharashtra State' dated 18.10.2023 indicating that the Applicant has already stands relieved on 18.10.2023 and directed to report to 'Government of Manipur' for implementation of Hon'ble Supreme Court, leaves no room to consider the prayers of the Applicant.

9. The provisions of Section 15(1) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 restricts the jurisdiction of all State Administrative Tribunals to adjudicate about Service Conditions of employees of the State Government, so long as they are working in organizations owned by the State Government or controlled by the State Government. The provisions of Section 15(1)(b) and Section 15(1)(c) are reproduced below:

"15(1)(b): all service matters concerning a person (not being a person referred to in clause (c) of this sub-section or a member person or civilian referred to in clause (b) of sub-section(1) of Section 14 appointed to any civil service of the State or any civil post under the State and pertaining to the service of such person in connection with the affairs of the State or of any local or other authority under the control of the State Government or of any corporation [or society] owned or controlled by the State Government;

15(1)(c): all service matters pertaining to service in connection with the affairs of the State concerning a person appointed to any service or post referred to in clause (b) being a person whose services have been placed by any such local or other authority or corporation [or society] or other body as is controlled or owned by the State Government at the disposal of the State Government for such appointment."

10. The Original Application No.1353 of 2023 is therefore dismissed on the grounds of jurisdiction under the provisions of Section 15(1) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. 'No Order as to Costs'.

the certificate of in-service training in the year 2003 and thereafter the period of 12 years was counted and so he was given Selection Grade in the year 2015. Thus the Applicant is counting the pay fixation from the year 2002 and the Department has counted from the year 2003 and therefore the period of 12 years for Selection Grade according to the Department is 2015.

- 4. Applicant was eligible on 23.07.2002 to appear for the Departmental in-service training. However, that training was not conducted in the year 2002 at all, but it was held in June, 2003. It is to be noted that in paragraph 8 of the order dated 08.02.2023 passed in O.A.No.472/2021 it is elaborated that it was not the fault of the Applicant not to participate in the in-service training earlier. It is noted that the Applicant cleared the examination in first attempt. It is also mentioned in the said judgment that the Applicant cannot be blamed for failure or negligence of the Department.

Therefore he has approached this Tribunal seeking relief that he is to be accommodated in a supernumerary post and the order of termination dated 31.12.2021 is to be quashed and set aside.
- 3. He relies on GRs dated 21.12.2019, 15.6.2020, 27.11.2020 & 28.10.2021. He submits that he has submitted proposal to the Revenue Department before 2013 and department forwarded the same to Caste Scrutiny Committee on 18.5.2013. As per GR dated 21.12.2019 there is mention of prescribed period which is 3 months from the date of appointment.

- 1. Heard Mr. S.C. Mangle, learned Counsel for the Applicant in M.A.No.609/2022, Mr. Bhushan A. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant in O.A.No.1044/2021 and Ms. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Learned Counsel Mr. Mangle has submitted that he has filed M.A. seeking intervention in O.A.No.1044/2021 filed by learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar.
- Applicant challenges the order of removal dated 18.01.2020 from the post of Constable so also the order of Appellate Authority thereby confirming the same on 14.10.2021. Learned Counsel Mr. Mangle has submitted that the Applicant in O.A. has suppressed the fact of his previous prosecution and arrest when he made his application for the post of Constable. Attestation form was filled on 07.07.2017 and he was arrested on 03.07.2017 and he was in custody. He was released on 05.07.2017. Learned Counsel Mr. Mangle has submitted that Applicant in O.A. was facing challenges under Section 376 of IPC, where the intervener (Applicant in M.A.) was the prosecutrix. Therefore she be allowed to assist the Presenting Officer in contesting

the O.A. Learned Advocate Mr. Mangle has submitted that after quashing of the FIR of the offence under Section 376 of IPC, the Original Applicant has still continued to harass the intervener under various offences.

- Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar has submitted that the FIR in the case under Section 376 is quashed by the Hon'ble High Court by order dated 26.11.2018 in Writ Petition No.496/2018. Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar has submitted that the Applicant in M.A. has no locus to intervene because the relief is sought against the authority who has removed the applicant after the D.E.. Applicant was not a witness in that D.E.
- In view of the submissions made by both the learned Counsel, we are of the view that charges levelled against the Applicant in D.E. were of misconduct and not pertaining to the Criminal trial as Moreover, the main contesting party is a Government who has removed the Applicant as a result of holding him guilty in the D.E.
- In view of the above, M.A. stands dismissed of. O.A. stands adjourned to 24.11.2023.
