- 7. Today, again learned C.P.O. has sought two weeks time.
- 8. It is desirable that the Respondents should consider the observations made above and to pass appropriate order. If it does not want to take appropriate step, they are at liberty to file reply within a week.
- 9. Matter is adjourned for filing reply and hearing.
