The Applicant by Transfer Order dated 15.05.2023 of the 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' was transferred from post of 'L.D.O., Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I), Solapur' to post of 'L.D.O, Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I)' Kolhapur'. The Applicant had completed Normal Tenure of 3 years on the post of 'L.D.O., Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I), Solapur' and had thus requested that he be transferred to any 'Vacant Posts' of L.D.O. at (i) Ule, Taluka South Solapur, District Solapur or (ii) Katgaon, Taluka Tuljapur, District Osmanabad or (iii) Sawargaon Kathi, Taluka Tuljapur, District Osmanabad or at (iv) Panchayat Samiti Extension, Taluka Tuljapur, District Osmanabad. However, none of the options submitted by Applicant were accepted and he was transferred to post of 'L.D.O, Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I)' Kolhapur'.</p> <p>4. The Transfer Order dated 15.05.2023 of Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' by which Applicant is posted as 'L.D.O, Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I)' Kolhapur' was sought to be justified on 'Administrative Grounds' viz (i) Vacant Posts of L.D.O.'s in Kolhapur District being very high at 49% and (ii) Applicant has stayed for of more than 13 years in Solapur District. However, in the course 'Final Hearing' when information was sought from 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' it was irrefutably established that unusually large number of 'L.D.O.'s in Pune Division have stayed on in their respective districts for continuous periods ranging from 15 years and to 25 years. Hence, the justification given for transfer of Applicant on 'Administrative Grounds' to post of 'L.D.O, Veterinary Dispensary (Grade-I)' Kolhapur' is not borne out by facts new divulged rather hesitantly by 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department'. There are over whelmingly large number of 'L.D.O.'s. who have completed tenure after tenure in same districts viz. Pune District; 'Solapur and Sangli, Districts'. No answers have been forthcoming from 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' as to why such over staying L.D.O.'s from 'Pune; Solapur and Sangli Districts' were never transferred to fill the 'Vacant posts' of 'L.D.O's in Kolhapur' District. Hence, against this background it is established beyond doubt that the decision to transfer Applicant. to post L.D.O.; Veterinary Dispensary (Grade -1) Kolhapur was result of an 'Arbitrary Exercise' of 'Statutory Powers'; but intelligently disguised as being taken for 'Administrative Reasons'.</p> <p data-bbox="799 1998 1528 2382">6. The 'Principal Secretary, Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' to look into these observations about syndicated transfers of LDO's in various districts of Pune Division. Such unethical practices need to be curbed with immediate effect. Hence it is directed that the representation of Applicant submitted on 16.05.2023 be considered afresh with an open mind and Applicant be posted to any 'Vacant Post' of LDO in 'Dharashiv District' which is in 'Chatrapati</p> |
