The present Misc. Application is made seeking restoration of Original Application No. 297/2013, which was dismissed in default by the order dated 17.02.2017 by condoning the delay of three years.

2. The applicant filed the Original Application No. 297/2023 seeking grant of promotion to the post of Daftar Karkoon with deemed date in that cadre on 21.02.1981. After admission, the O.A. was fixed for final hearing on 17.02.2017, on which date the same was dismissed in default, as nobody was present on behalf of the applicant.

3. The applicant after his retirement on superannuation in the year 2014 shifted his residence to Pune along with his family members. He has occasionally met his Advocate and his Advocate was telling him that regular Division Bench is not available for final hearing. However, when the applicant went to this Tribunal on 26.2.2020 to find

out stage of his O.A., it was revealed that the same was dismissed in default on 17.02.2017. Thereafter, when the applicant approached his Advocate, he did not return the papers. He was compelled to engage new Advocate through whom he has filed the present Misc. Application with accompanying O.A.

4. It is the contention of the applicant that he was never informed the dates of hearing by his previous Advocate. The Original Application was dismissed in default, as his previous Advocate did not remain present at the time of hearing. The delay is not deliberate or intentional. Hence, the present Misc. Application.

5. In spite of grant of opportunities, the affidavit in reply is not filed on behalf of respondents.

7. Perusal of the Original Application would show that after completion of pleadings, the O.A. was admitted as per farad sheet order dated 10.06.2014 and thereafter, it was fixed for final hearing in due course of time. Thereafter, the O.A. appeared for final hearing on the board of 15.02.2017, on which date nobody was present on behalf of the applicant. Hence, it was fixed for final hearing on 17.02.2017 and on that date, it was dismissed in default.

8. In the circumstances as above, we find substance in the contentions raised on behalf of the applicant that for considerable period the matter was not shown in the final hearing category and in short interval of two dates, the O.A. has been dismissed in default. Previous Advocate of the applicant seems to have remained present at the time of hearing. No doubt the applicant is literate person and he should have kept track of the matter. However, his contention that he believed his previous Advocate, who was telling him that for want of non-availability of Division Bench, the matter was not fixed for final hearing cannot be out rightly discarded, is having substance.

The applicant claims that after completion of 24 years of service, he was entitled for pay scale of Rs. 6,000-10,000. The applicant completed 12 years of service in the year 1998. He was granted first time bound promotion pay scale after completion of 12 years of service by the order dated 30.06.2003 w.e.f. 06.06.1999 in the pay scale of Rs. 4500-7000. The applicant submitted application dated 08.07.2008 to the respondents to grant second time bound promotion in the pay scale of Rs. 5500-9000 instead of 5000-8000. In view of subsequent G.R. dated 5.11.2008, the applicant is entitled for pay scale of Rs. 6000-10000 as first time bound promotion as of Assistant Project Officer and he has passed B.Ed / B.P. Ed. The said benefit was not granted to him.

Second time bound promotion was also not granted to the applicant initially after completion of 24 years of service, which is granted only during pendency of this litigation. The applicant made detailed representation dated 04.05.2017 to the respondent No. 3. The respondent No. 3 sent the said representation with proposal to the respondent No. 2. However, benefits were not granted to the applicant. The applicant came to know about the necessary Government Resolution after his retirement on 30.06.2012. He was waiting for response on his representation dated 04.05.2017. Hence, there is delay, which is not deliberate or intentional. Hence, the present Misc. Application.

6. After having considered the contentions raised in this application, it can be seen that during pendency of the present proceeding the claim of the applicant of second time bound promotion is considered. The applicant is fighting for his legitimate dues. No doubt, there is delay of about six years and six months caused in filing the accompanying O.A., the same cannot be said to be deliberate or intentional one. It is a settled principle of law that the expression "sufficient cause" is to be construed liberally. In the facts and circumstances as above, refusing to condone the delay is likely to defeat the cause of justice at the threshold. In the circumstances, in our considered opinion, this is a fit case to condone the delay by imposing the moderate costs of Rs. 1,000/- on the applicant. Hence, we proceed to pass the following order :-
