Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant is 'Clerk Typist' in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' and seeks transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Kolhapur Range, Kolhapur'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that Applicant had made representations to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' for transfer to establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Kolhapur Range, Kolhapur' on 21.09.2022 and 03.07.2022.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate then mentions that several 'Clerk Typists' who had applied after Applicant to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' have been transferred by (i) Transfer Order of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' dated 10.02.2023 for '6 Clerk Typists' and (ii) 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' Order dated 07.03.2024 for '27 Clerk Typists'.</p> <p>5. The reasons of seeking 'NOC' from various 'Police Establishments' such (i) Commissioners of Police and (ii) Superintendents of Police before issuing 'Transfer Order' however needs to be explained by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' if it is 'Cadre Controlling Authority' for 'Clerk Typists' in respect of all 'Police Establishments' across Maharashtra State. If so; transfer of 'Clerk Typist' can be done after following the due procedure 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in P.T.O.</p>

Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' without any requirement of 'NOC' from other 'Police Establishments' but upon ascertaining availability of 'Vacant Posts' of 'Clerk Typists' as well as assessment of the overall requirements of such 'Police Establishments'.

6. Learned P.O. states that case of the Applicant was duly considered by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' as letter was also written to him on 30.06.2023 seeking 'Medical Certificate' before 'Transfer Orders' came to be issued on 07.03.2024 by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' for several other 'Clerk Typists'. However, 'Medical Certificate' has still not been submitted by Applicant and this was the main reason why Applicant's request could not be considered by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.

7. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that 'Medical Certificate' had already been submitted but still request of Applicant was not considered by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' at the time of issue of 'Transfer Orders' on 07.03.2024 in respect of 27 'Clerk Typists'.

8. The 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is therefore informed to reconcile about asymmetry on information with regard to submission of 'Medical Certificate' by Applicant. Thereafter if it is found available on 'Office Record', then 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' to relieve Applicant to join on establishment of 'Spl. I.G.P. Kolhapur Range, Kolhapur' if other 'Clerk Typists' who are junior to Applicant have been relieved on 10.02.2023 and 07.03.2024.

9. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 05.04.2024.

Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant who is working as 'Craft Instructor (Turner)' at I.T.I., Rajguru Nagar, Tahsil Khed, District Pune' has been posted to 'I.T.I., Aundh, Tahsil Haveli, District Pune' by 'Transfer Order' dated 12.01.2024 of 'Joint Director, Vocational Education and Training, Pune'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that 'Wife' of Applicant is also working as 'Craft Instructor (Dress Making)' at 'I.T.I., Rajguru Nagar, Tahsil Khed, District Pune' as they were posted together by 'Transfer Order' dated 31.05.2023 of 'Joint Director, Vocational Education and Training, Pune'; although at that time they had requested to be post together to 'I.T.I., Aundh, Tahsil Haveli, District Pune'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then draws attention to the fact that 'Mother' and 'Son' of Applicant are both afflicted by 'Mental Illness' and therefore are completely dependent on Applicant. Hence, if Applicant was to be transferred 'Mid-Term' but not alongwith his 'Wife' to 'I.T.I., Aundh, Tahsil Haveli, District Pune' then it would amount to immense 'Personal Hardships' for his 'Family Members'.</p> <p>5. Learned P.O. emphasized with 'Transfer Order' dated 12.01.2024 of 'Joint Director, Vocational Education and Training, Pune' has been issued in accordance with earlier request made by Applicant to be posted to 'I.T.I., Aundh, Tahsil Haveli, District Pune'.</p>

6. Learned Advocate for Applicant then drew attention to the 'Office Order' dated 29.01.2024 of 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' by which services of Applicants who are posted in 'Central Prison' at 'Nashik' have been attached to 'Central Prisons at Kolhapur, Amravati and Nagpur'.</li> <li>5. Learned Advocate for Applicant then refers to 'Home Department' letter dated 21.02.2024 addressed to 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' by which the proposal for transfer of Applicants was returned back as no supportive documents had been attached. Further it conveyed that the proposal may be resubmitted alongwith relevant documents to 'Home Department'.</li> </ol>

The 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' letter dated 29.01.2024 to 'Principal Secretary, Home Department, Maharashtra State' refers to occurrence of certain incidents in 'Central Prison' at 'Nashik' which apparently had been brought to knowledge by complainant Shri Maruti Kamble on 10.10.2023. However, the proposal for transfer of Applicants submitted by 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' on 29.01.2024 was almost '3 Months' after compliant had been made by Shri Maruti Kamble on 10.10.2023. The 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' letter dated 29.01.2024 also does not mention whether the compliant made by Shri Maruti Kamble on 10.10.2023 was enquired into or if it had been classified as 'Anonymous Compliant' as per provisions of 'G.A.D. G.R. dated 25.02.2015.</p> <p>7. The 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' evidently did not submit complete information to 'Home Department' with regard to status of the complaint made by Shri Maruti Kamble on 10.10.2023 so as to justify the proposal for transfer of Applicants, but on the other hand acted in undue haste to temporarily attach the services of Applicants to 'Central Prisons' at 'Kolhapur, Amravati and Nagpur'. The 'Office Order' dated 29.01.2024 of 'Additional D.G.P. of Prisons &amp; Correctional Services, Maharashtra State, Pune' does not refer to any provisions of 'The Prison Act, 1894' or 'Maharashtra Prison Manual, 1979' or 'Administrative Instructions' of 'Home Department' which permit to temporarily attachment of services of 'Jailer Group - I &amp; Jailer Group - II' serving in 'Central Prisons'. The transfer of 'Jailer Group - I &amp; Jailer Group - II' would be required to be done under provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' by the 'Home Department'.</p> <p>8. (c) If the Petitioner (Shri Salim Mohd. Hanif Shaikh) before us or the intervenor Petitioner (Shri Sunil Gorulal Rathi) are eligible to be considered for temporary promotions, the Applicant State Authorities would consider their candidature strictly as per the rules, not with standing the pendency of this litigation.

(d) So also, if the original Petitioner (Shri Salim Mohd.
