She further submitted that the height is measured in three readings on one machine. Thus, there were total 12 readings and every time is height is shown as 164.7 and 164.8

4. We have considered the submissions of learned Advocate and learned P.O. . We did not find any ground to reject the submissions of learned P.O. who is also instructed by Mr. Yogesh Kumar, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Head Quarter, Mumbai. For measuring the proper procedure is followed as there are 12 readings in respect of the measurement of the height of the Applicant.

5. We are of the view that there is no procedural flaw or any particular step which is missed by the Respondent. Under such circumstances we are of the view that it is not necessary to send the applicant to any physical test. No merit is found in the present case. Hence, O.A. is dismissed.
