#### ORDER

- 1. The Applicant is retiring on 30.04.2023, hence, utmost urgency; so we have taken up this matter for hearing.
- 2. Applicant was working as Assistant Commissioner (Food) and Designated Officer Group-A as he prays to quash and set aside the memorandum dated 27.09.2018 initiating the Departmental Enquiry against him for the charges mentioned therein. He further prays to quash and set aside the suspension order dated 16.08.2018 issued by the Joint Secretary to the Government.
- 3. Applicant submits that on 19.03.2018 he suspended the license of M/s. Vaidyanath Sahakari Sakhar Karkhana Maryadit for 10 days. Pursuant to that he was by order dated 16.08.2018 was suspended from

the service on the ground that his action of suspending license of the said Sugar Factory was without having any authority and power and in breach of Rule 23 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Conduct) Rules 1979.

- 4. Applicant has submitted that the enquiry is illegal and he challenges the enquiry on the following grounds:
  - (a) The Enquiry is illegal.
  - (b) In the Affidavit-in-reply of Respondent No.3, it is admitted that Applicant is having powers under Section 32(3) of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.
  - (c) Enquiry Officer has long back concluded enquiry on 10.11.2021.
- 5. We are informed by learned C.P.O. that the file is prepared and now proposal whether to accept the enquiry report or to disagree and proceed further is pending. It is concluded by the enquiry officer holding him charges not proved and till today the Department has not taken any decision. Learned C.P.O. further submitted that the file is pending before the Hon'ble Minister since 09.03.2023.
- 6. We have perused affidavit-in-reply dated December 2019 filed on behalf of Respondent No.3, the Central Licensing Authority and Food Safety and Standards Authority of India through Mr. V.K. Pancham, Joint Director, Food Safety & Standards Authority of India, Ministry of Health. Paragraphs 9 and 10 of the affidavit reads as below:
  - "9. That Respondent No.3, vide letter dated 30.09.2019 has reiterated that State Food Safety Authorities are to keep the Central Licensing Authorities informed of the cases of non-compliances and subsequent action by State Food Safety Authorities

10. That it is respectfully submitted that all actions by the Applicant, being the Assistant Commissioner of the Food and Drug Authority (who was working as DO) at that time) Beed were done in accordance with the powers delegated to him under the FSS Act, 2006, read with the Rules and Regulations. That Applicant has not gone beyond the powers delegated under the letters issued by the Respondent No.3 as also mentioned above. The Applicant was fully authorized to act in accordance with the powers delegated under the FSS Act."

(emphasis placed)

- 7. We have gone through Section 32(3) of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 which reads as below:
  - "32 (3) If the food business operator still fails to comply with the improvement notice, the Designated Officer may, after giving the licensee an opportunity to show cause, cancel the license granted to him."

In this matter improvement notice was given then the action of suspending license was taken as per the law. We have also gone through Section 16(5) of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 which reads as below:

"16(5) The Food Authority may, from time to time give such directions, on matters relating to food safety and standards, to the Commissioner of Food Safety, who shall be bound by such directions while exercising his powers under this Act."

- 8. Our attention was drawn to copy of letter dated 10.11.2021 issued by the Enquiry Officer to the Joint Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department. He pointed out that the Enquiry Officer has sent the entire file with the report to the concerned Department on 10.11.2021.
- 9. In view of above, we pass the following order:

It is surprisingly shocking and we fail to understand why the Disciplinary Authority is so indecisive in view of clear legal position. Hence, we give only two days to the Respondents to take decision. It is to be noted that only two days are given as the Applicant is going to retire on 30.04.2023.

- 1. Heard Shri S. D. Patil, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant has challenged the order dated 17.04.2023 whereby Applicant is shown repatriated to Water Resources Department. The order dated 17.04.2023 is issued by Respondent No.1 Soil and Water Conservation Department.
- 3. The Applicant contends that his parent department is Respondent No.2 Water Resources Department and it is not a case of deputation so as to repatriate him. That apart, he contends that he is retiring at the end of May, 2023 and, therefore, requested for interim relief.
- 4. Learned P.O. opposes interim relief *inter-alia* contending that Applicant is rightly repatriated to Respondent No.2 and it is approved by the CSB as well as competent Authority (Hon'ble Chief Minister).
- 5. Leaving aside the issue as to which department is parent department of the Applicant and as to whether he was on deputation, the fact remains that he is retiring at the end of May, 2023. Though, the impugned order is termed as repatriation to parent department it has effect of displacement from present post at Satara. In terms of Section 5(1) of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005, the tenure of Government servant can be extended where he is due to retire in less than one year period. As such, it has trapping of mid-term and mid-tenure displacement.

- 6. In view of above, I am inclined to grant interim relief to stay implementation of order dated 17.04.2023 qua the Applicant.
