



7. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
8. S.O. to 20.07.2018.
9. Respondent No.1 while replying to the O.A. should particularly consider the request of the Applicant for adjustment in the vacant post suggested by him.
10. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that he has no difficulty in joining at the transfer post. He should comply with the instructions accordingly.
11. Meanwhile, the request made by the Applicant be considered sympathetically by the competent authority and report the progress by 20.07.2018.
