- 4. It is contention of the applicant that claim of the applicant is rejected by taking recourse of the repealed Act namely the provision of Persons with Disability Act (Equal

Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995.

- 5. Learned C.P.O. for the respondents submits that he has to seek instructions from the respondents as to why the repealed Act has been referred, to deny appointment of the applicant.
- 6. Considering the facts and circumstances as discussed above and purport of impugned letter dated 04.06.2021, in our opinion, it is just and proper to grant ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 10 (E) till filing of the affidavit in reply by the respondents in order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings. Order accordingly.
- 7. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 05.07.2021.
- 8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
