


The learned Counsel for Applicant submits that the Applicant was selected from Batch No.102 for the post of 'PSI' in 'General Category' in 2011. The Applicant has initially appointed as 'Police Constable' in the Category of 'OBC'. However, by GR dated 19.07.2011 the said caste of 'Vaishya Wani' was deleted from the list of 'OBC'.</p> <p>3. The Learned Counsel for Applicant further submits that although initially Applicant was appointed as Police Constable in reserved category of 'OBC' in 2001 but thereafter, Respondent No.1 State vide Notification dated 15.02.2008 had conducted 'Limited Competitive Departmental Examination' for the post of 'Police Sub Inspector'. The Applicant applied for the post of 'Police Sub Inspector' meant for candidates belonging to 'General Category' and Respondent No.1 on the recommendation made by Respondent No.3 had appointed Applicant to the post of 'Police Sub Inspector' against post meant for 'General Category'.</p>
