"It is submitted that the Hon'ble Apex Court in Capt. M. Paul Anthoy's case reported in (1999) 3 SCC 679 held that "since the appellant has been acquitted we would not direct any fresh departmental enquiry to be instituted against him on the same set of facts, the appellant shall be reinstated forthwith and shall also be paid entire arrears of salary together with all allowances from the date of suspension till his retirement." In view of this settled position of law the act of respondents denying the benefit of suspension period i.e. increment in salary for that period is unsustainable and bad in law."

5. However, Id. P.O. submits that facts of that case might be different than this case. In view of applicant's exoneration from the Court and set of

facts, applicant is granted relief clause on P.B. Pg. No. 7, 8-A with following conditions:-

- A. O.A. is partly allowed.
- B. Applicant's suspension period is to be treated as duty period notionally and applicant will be given increment for that period notionally without any actual monitory benefits of that period or backwages.
- C. Subsequent to that applicant's pension will be revised accordingly.
- D. However, other relief clause in para no. 8 i.e.B, C and D are rejected.
- E. Similarly, applicant will not be entitled to claim any interest since he is not granted any monitory benefit in the form of backwages.
