These Notifications and the provisions of Bombay Government Premises (Eviction) Act, 1956 are thoroughly discussed in the said judgment.

4. Today, learned P.O. tendered order dated 21.12.2022 issued by the Joint Commissioner of Police, Mumbai for withdrawal of eviction notice which is subject matter in the present O.A. with liberty to avail the proceeding of Bombay Government Premises (Eviction) Act, 1956. The letter is taken on record and marked by letter 'X'.

5. In O.A., the Applicant has challenged recovery order dated 11.02.2021 also and prayed for refund of Rs.1,00,320/-. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that after filing of O.A also recovery is continued from Pay & Allowances and till date Rs.1,91,520/- are recovered.

6. Insofar as recovery is concerned, the challenges to recovery order dated 11.02.2021 is still there which is not cancelled by the Respondents. They have cancelled only eviction order dated 03.11.2021.

8. O.A., therefore, will have to be heard on merit in respect of recovery order.

9. Learned P.O. is directed to come prepareand argue the matter.

Indeed, the Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 10.01.2022 passed in suo moto W.P.No.03/2020 held that in cases where the limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022, notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all persons shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022. Whereas, R.A. is filed on 07.10.2022. As such, the delay comes to near about 4 months and not 7 months.

5. In the interest of justice, I am inclined to condone the delay so as to decide the R.A. on its own merit.

6. M.A. is accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs. $\hfill \hfill \$
