The Writ Petition No.920/2020 was regarding rights of the petitioner to protection of Government Service and grant of consequential Service Benefits. In Para 16 of the Judgment it has been observed that <i>"It is also worth while to note that the benefits which are being claimed are not those arising out of any caste claim of as employee, but are benefits which are available to all employees in general, if they fulfill the relevant criteria and thus cannot be denied to the petitioner, who now has to be treated on par with a general employee, and as such would be entitled to such benefits."</i></p> <p>3. The copy of the Judgment passed by High Court of Judicature at Bombay Nagpur Bench in Writ Petition No.920 of 2020 dated 07.10.2023 be forwarded to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' as the Applicant in this O.A. No. 1062 of 2023 seeks to be treated at par with other similarly placed 'P.S.I.'s. Learned Advocate Applicant</p>

Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that 'Directorate of Vocational Education and Training, Mumbai' has excluded 'Orthopedically Handicapped Candidates' in the impugned Advertisement No.1/2022 issued on 17.08.2022 and therefore did not consider the Applicant who is 'Physically Handicapped (Locomotor)' when 'Provisional Selection List' post of 'Crafts Instructors' was published on 07.12.2023, 08.12.2023 and 11.12.2023.

Learned Advocate for the Applicant thereupon states that against this backdrop the present 'Additional D.G.P. (Traffic), Maharashtra State, Mumbai' by Order</p>

dated 12.12.2023 has suddenly relieved 'Police Head Constables'/'Police Constables'/'Police Naiks-Drivers' including the Applicants and directed them to join back on their parent establishment of 'SP Nandurbar' on the ground of they had completed their periods of deputation by retrospectively cancelling the Orders for extension of One Year granted on 27.01.2023, 21.02.2023, 31.03.2023, and 05.06.2023.

6. Learned P.O. states that the cause of action of Applicants has arisen in 'Nandurbar District' which comes under jurisdiction of 'Aurangabad Bench' of MAT, and therefore cannot be heard by the 'Mumbai Bench' of MAT. However, he also admits that the Applicants had been appointed by 'Order Deputation' dated 05.04.2018 and now relieved by 'Order of Repatriation' dated 12.12.2023 of 'Additional D.G.P. (Traffic), Maharashtra State, Mumbai'. Further learned PO states that names of substitute 'Police Head Constables', 'Police Constable' / 'Drive-Police Naiks' have also been received from 'SP, Nandurbar' who are be posted in place of Applicants.

7. The O.A. No. 1599/2023 was heard on 20.12.2023 and factual information was sought from, learned P.O. Learned PO was also directed to contact the 'Additional D.G.P. (Traffic), Maharashtra State, Mumbai' to find out about 'Rules' & 'Regulations' of Home Department or 'Circular & Orders' of the 'DGP Maharashtra' State relating to Appointments on Deputation of 'Police Head Constable'/'Police Constables' / 'Police Naik Driver' on the establishment of 'Additional D.G.P. (Traffic), Maharashtra State, Mumbai'. The 'Order on Deputation' dated 05.04.2028 as well as 'Order of Repatriation' dated 12.12.2023 of the Applicants have *prima facie* not been issued as per provision of 'Section 22J-(3) & Section 22J-(4) of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.
