2. The Applicant stands retired in 2016 but his retirement benefits were withheld due to Departmental Enquiry (D.E.). After retirement of the Applicant, D.E. has been completed on 03.11.2018 and punishment of deduction of 6% pension for one year has been imposed by order dated 03.11.2018 which seems to have been not challenged by the Applicant.
3. Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that he is not challenging the punishment order but there is no reason to withhold the retirement benefits namely Gratuity, GPF, GIS etc.
4. Whereas, learned P.O. has pointed out that there are dues of Rs.20,11,763/- towards housing advance, computer advance, credit society and quarter rent. He has further pointed out that provisional pension is already granted.
5. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that he will call his client to verify that any such amount is due and payable and will take necessary steps in this behalf.
6. On request of learned Counsel for the Applicant, two weeks time is granted to file Rejoinder, if any as well as to take further appropriate steps in respect of payment of Rs.20,11,763/- to the department so that O.A. can be disposed of and Applicant should get his legitimate dues without further loss of time.

The limited relief is claimed in the O.A. is as follows:  <i>"9(a) :- By a suitable order/direction, this Hon'ble Tribunal may be pleased to set aside the impugned notice dated 20.11.2020 issued by the Respondent No.1 (Exb.A) based on the impugned order to that effect passed by the Respondent No.2 on 04.11.2020 (Exb.-B) to the extent to which the same has been denied to the Petitioners the monthly pay and allowances in the event they fail to furnish the original Project Affected Person Certificate and accordingly the Petitioners be granted all the consequential service benefits, as if the impugned order had not been passed."</i></p> <p>3. Admittedly, till date the Applicant is in service of the Respondents. However, the pay and allowances are not paid since November 2020 on the ground of non furnishing of original Project Affected Person Certificate.</p> <p>4. Learned Counsel for the Applicants submits that since the Respondents are availing the services of the Applicant, his pay and allowances cannot be withheld in this manner. He therefore, submits that the present O.A. is restricted to the grant of pay and allowances and directions be accordingly issued to the Respondents.</p> <p align="right">[P.T.O.]</p>

**Tribunal's orders**

5. Learned Counsel has further pointed out that way back in 2002, the Respondent No.1 by letter dated 25.06.2002 (page 87 of PB) asked the Applicant to produce original certificate which the Applicant has accordingly submitted on 24.11.2020 with his letter (Page 88 of PB) but the office of the Respondent No.1 had lost the certificate, and therefore, Applicant cannot be blamed for it.
6. The Applicant has challenged the communication dated 20.11.2020 which is the show cause notice issued by the Respondent No.1 to Applicant that his pay and allowances will not be paid till the production of original certificate and also to show cause as to why he should not be terminated from service.
7. Learned Counsel for the Applicants made fair submission that O.A. is restricted to the grant of pay and allowances so long as the Applicant is in service.
8. Admittedly, the Applicant is in service and so long as he is in service and work is expected from him, his pay and allowances cannot be denied.
9. Learned P.O. could not point out any provision to deny pay and allowances to the Applicant during his service period.
10. In view of above, Original Application is disposed of with direction to Respondent No.1 to release pay and allowances of the Applicant during tenure of his service.
11. It is hereby made clear that the Respondent is at liberty to take further recourse of law against the Applicant as may be permissible in law.
12. Original Application is accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs.

**Tribunal's orders**

4. This matter was taken up for hearing in morning session and on request of learned P.O., it was kept in afternoon session for taking necessary instructions from the Respondent No.1. However, in the second session, learned P.O. again requested for adjournment stating that she wants to take further instructions from Respondent No.1 about the compliance of the order dated 22.12.2020.

5. Indeed, in terms of order passed by this Tribunal, the Respondent No.1 was bond to submit the compliance report by today but neither the compliance report is submitted nor there is any explanation for non compliance of the order. Thus, it appears that Respondent No.1 has totally ignored the directions given by the Tribunal. They seem to have no regard for the orders passed by the Tribunal and *prima-facie* liable for action under contempt of court act for willful disobedience of the order passed by the Tribunal.

6. In view of above, issue show cause notice to Principal Secretary, Public Health Department as to why *suo moto* cognizance of the contempt of court should not be taken for prosecution under contempt of court Act.






