In view of this G.R., it appears that respondents are under compulsion to follow the G.R. and call D.P.C. by regular method or by circulation and take the decision of Applicant on provisional promotion as per sr.nos. 6 and 9 of page 4/13 of G.R. dated 15.12.2017 within 30 days from the receipt of date of this order. 4. The Respondents / Disciplinary authority is empowered as Appointing Authority to take the decision as per G.R. dated 15.12.2017 after two years from D.P.C. meeting which have been kept in sealed cover envelop of such employees. 5. The relevant portion of order is on page no.90. The dismissal order has been passed by the Additional Commissioner of Police, Pune city. Subsequently, the Applicant has submitted an appeal to Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department, Maharashtra State vide order dated 16.08.2016, page 448 of VOL.4 . After hearing of appeal of the Applicant, it appears that appeal was heard by the Hon'ble State Minister (Urban) and order passed on 11.12.2018, Exb-B, page no.91 to 94, Vol.1. The appeal has been rejected. Now the Applicant has approached this Tribunal and contention of the Applicant is that his appointing authority is Commissioner of Police while he has been dismissed by order dated 15.06.2016, Exb. 'A', page 86, Vol.1 by Additional Commissioner of Police. His argument is that an officer below appointing authority cannot dismiss the Applicant. In view of this, it is necessary to take reply of all the Respondents. Learned C.P.O. has filed reply on behalf of Respondent Nos.2 to 6. However, Respondent No.1 has not filed reply till now.</p> <p>3. It is very crucial O.A. The Applicant was dismissed as Police Naik as per order dated 15.06.2016, page no.86 of Vol.1 and to adjudicate the matter since policy decision of Home Department/Police Department is involved regarding appointing authority or disciplinary authority, affidavit on record is very necessary by Respondent No.1.</p>

5. Apart from above, following two documents are also required to adjudicate the matter i.e. D.P.C. which was held in 2008 as per Ex.R1, page 622 to 624 where Applicant's name appeared at Sr.No.281 on page no.624, Vol.1.

6. On submission made by learned C.P.O. the applicant was appointed on 06.07.1991 in Pune as a proof of that learned CPO has shown original service book of the Applicant. She is directed to file relevant record of service book. On 3rd page of Service Book, it appears that the Additional Commissioner of Police has taken back the Applicant in service on 13.11.1992 after giving warning. This order has been passed by the Additional Commissioner of Police, Pune city on 13.11.1992. Learned C.P.O. has submitted documents written by Deputy Commissioner of Police Head Quarter 1 of Commissioner of Police, Pune City dated 01.08.2015 to director General of Police (Desk 12) in the first para itself it is written that in his establishment deputy Commissioner head quarter post has been upgraded on 29.01.1988 to Additional Police Commissioner post as new post and from 12.06.2001 the post of Deputy Commissioner of Police head quarter is vacant. The Deputy Commissioner of Police Head Quarter is a new post which has been created. During the period from 1988 to 2001 since the Deputy Commissioner Head Quarter post was not there, an appointing authority for Police Constable post will be to Additional Police Commissioner and he has been directed that since between 1988 to 2001 there is absence of DCP Head Quarter, Additional Commissioner of police should act as appointing authority of police constables. Learned C.P.O. is directed to file this letter on record.





