

Today learned P.O. has filed Affidavit-in-Reply on behalf of Respondent No.1 in both the O.As. In Affidavit all that it is stated that the matter is in process and Respondents will decide D.E. at the earliest.</p> <p>5. Learned P.O. sought to contend that due to COVID-19 Pandemic situation and it being joint enquiry of total 14 delinquent, it is delayed and now final order will be passed at the earliest.</p> <p>6. Indeed, the Affidavit filed by Shri Amol N. Sakharkar, Under Secretary is silent about the steps taken in the matter from time to time to show diligence. The enquiry officer has submitted report on 19.09.2019 and now period of more than 2 years and 6 months is over but astonishingly till date no final decision is taken and matter seems pending without substantial</p>

progress. In Affidavit it is stated that reminders were sent to the Respondent No.2 – The Commissioner for Agriculture and the report of Director (Horticulture) was received on 21.03.2022. Indeed, it was for Disciplinary Authority to examine report and to pass final order in accordance to law within reasonable time.

7. Indeed, as per provision of Departmental Enquiry Manual and circular dated 07.04.2008, enquiry was required to be completed maximum within one year and where enquiry is not completed within one year specific order for extension of time is required to be obtained from the Head of the Department. In the present matter admittedly no such extension was sought. Suffice to say Respondents acted in derogation of circular dated 07.04.2008. As per the said circular if enquiry remains pending for five years or more, Government is under obligation to fix responsibility and to take Departmental action against the concerned for such inordinate delay. But there is complete defiance of circular dated 07.04.2008.

8. Had Respondent No.1 acted diligently and monitored enquiry the matter would have attended finality much earlier. Suffice to say there is inordinate and huge delay in completion of D.E. as well as for passing final order in D.E. This inordinate delay has deprived the Applicants from getting their remaining retiral benefits. Negligence and laxity on the part of concerned is obvious.

9. In view of above, Principal Secretary, Agriculture is directed to file Affidavit to explain the delay caused in finalizing D.E. and also to explain the steps taken by him after receipt of D.E. Affidavit should be filed within seven days.


