- 7. We wish to know the point of view of the Secretary, when he came to know that criminal cases were pending against various persons who were promoted.
- 8. Therefore, Shri Ashish Kumar Singh, Principal Sccretary, Public Works Department, is directed to file affidavit on following points:
  - (i) While approving para wise remarks/affidavit to be filed in the present case, did he find that the information relating to criminal case/FIR pending against officers named in para 7.2 to 7.5 was required to be placed before the committee and duc to failure to place that information, the said decision was vitiated.
  - (ii) Has he enquired the circumstances in which the information was withheld/not disclosed before the DPC at that time.
  - (iii) Whether he considers it necessary that either applicant's case be processed for reconsideration or cases of promotion of

officers named in para 7.2 to 7.5 be processed for reopening, in the background that those promotions would amount to violating policy of State which was applied in the applicant's case.

- 9. Affidavit be filed within three weeks from today.
