2. The Applicant was dismissed from service by order dated 14.09.2012. Thereafter, the Applicant has filed appeal which was partly allowed and by order dated 22.11.2017 the order of dismissal was set aside and punishment of reduction to lower stage for three years was passed. By the said order, the period from 14.09.2012 that the date of dismissal to the date of reinstatement in service was ordered to be treated no duty period except for pension purpose. However, the order of Appellate Authority was conveyed to the Applicant belatedly and, therefore, he could join only on 28.10.2018. On the above background, the Applicant has filed the present O.A. for pay and allowances for the entire period from 14.09.2012 to 28.10.2018 and in alternative period for pay and allowances at least for the period from 22.11.2017 to 28.10.2018 alleging that despite the order of reinstatement in service, he was ^{not} reinstated in service within reasonable time and the order of reinstatement was served upon him belatedly. The Applicant has also file representation dated 31.11.2018 requesting the Respondent No.2 i.e Deputy Commissioner of Police for grant of allowances for the period from 22.11.2017 to 28.10.2018. However, the said representation is not yet decided.

3. Learned P.O. sought time to file Affidavit-in-Reply.

4. Enough chances are already granted. However, ten days time is lastly granted for filing reply with direction to decide the representation dated 31.11.2018 in the meantime and apprise the Tribunal about the same.
