4. Learned PO is then informed that no explanation has been forth coming from 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' as to why directions given from time to time including in (a) 'Para 7' and 'Para 8' of Order dated 16.02.2023 and (b) 'Para 8' of Order dated 28.06.2024.

2. M.A.No.415/2024 is filed seeking transfer of O.A.No.175/2023 filed at M.A.T. Bench Nagpur to M.A.T. Mumbai under Section 25 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 as similar issue is already decided earlier.

3. Learned C.P.O. has submitted that the copy of M.A. is not served to the office of C.P.O.

Learned Counsel has submitted that 4 Applicant, Medical Officer has already retired on 31.05.2024. He has submitted that the O.A. pertains to extension of superannuation age of Doctors from 58 years to 60 years and in the present case Applicant be reinstated 'in service. Learned Counsel has submitted that Shri Justice M.G. Giratkar, Vice-Chairman(J) M.A.T. Bench Nagpur has taken different view on this issue which was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Nagpur dated 31.01.2024 passed in W.P.No.733/2024, (Dr. Milind V State of Maharashtra and others). He therefore granted leave to move before Principal Bench at Mumbai.

5. This Tribunal has granted the interim relief in similar matter in many cases. We make it clear that we have already heard group of matters involving in the issue of extension of age from 58 years to 60 years and the same is reserved for orders. However, we have passed order in some matters where the Doctors have approached for Interim Relief for grant of extension of age of superannuation from 58 years to 60 years.

6. In view of above, M.A.No.414/2024 is hereby allowed. O.A. can be transferred from M.A.T. Bench Nagpur to M.A.T., Mumbai. Learned Counsel is directed to serve copy(hard-copy) of M.A. and O.A. to all the concern.
