2. Learned Advocate for Applicant presents copy of Order dated 15.07.2024 of 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai' issued in respect of 996 posts of 'Police Constable' which were earmarked for 'Inter District Transfer' for year 2022-2023.

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that this Order dated 15.07.2024 of 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai' includes 'Inter District Transfer' of 'Police Constables' to 44 posts earmarked in establishment of 'SP, Raigad' but it also includes 8 posts which were available from year 2020-21 and were carried forward for year 2022-2023 as mentioned in letter dated 03.04.2024 written by 'Additional D.G.P., Training & Special Squads, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' to 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai'.

4. Learned PO is then informed that no explanation has been forth coming from 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' as to why directions given from time to time including in (a) 'Para 7' and 'Para 8' of Order dated 16.02.2023 and (b) 'Para 8' of Order dated 28.06.2024.

5. The 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' without complying with these directions has issued Order dated 15.07.2024 for 'Inter District Transfers' of 996 posts of 'Police Constables' for year 2022-2023 but by including 44 posts earmarked in establishment of 'SP Raigad'.

6. The 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' had no compelling reason what so ever to include in Order dated 15.07.2024 earmarked 44 posts of 'Police Constables' in establishment 'SP, Raigad'; as

specific directions had been given in 'Para 8' of Order dated 28.06.2024 to indicate how these 44 posts would be filled-up on the basis of the 'Seniority No's and (a) 1st Choice (b) 2nd Choice, and (c) 3rd Choice from amongst all those 'Police Constables' who had opted for 'Inter District Transfer' in establishment of 'SP, Raigad'; including the Applicants.

7. The implementation of Order dated 15.07.2024 of 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai' in respect 'Inter Establishment Transfers' to earmarked 44 posts of 'Police Constables' for year 2022-2023 in establishment of 'SP Raigad' is therefore stayed till 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai' files 'Affidavit-in-Reply' as per specific directions in 'Para 8' of the Order dated 28.06.2024 as well the compelling reasons to issue of Order dated 15.07.2024 in respect of earmarked 44 posts of 'Police Constables' in establishment 'SP, Raigad'; and explanation about what held back his hand from issuing 'Supplementary Order' as per directions given in 'Para 7' Order dated 17.08.2023 after 'SP Raigad' had confirmed availability of additional 8 posts for 'Inter District Transfer' of 'Police Constables' on 14.07.2023 for year 2020-2021.

8. The 'Additional DG, SRPF, Maharashtra State Mumbai' to be forthwith informed about the Orders of 'Status Quo' by learned PO. 
