These two orders dated 09.09.2018 and 19.12.2019 are under challenged in O.A.
- 4. As regard limitation, the Applicant ought to have filed O.A. in respect of order dated 09.09.2018 upto 09.09.2019. However, he contends that due to COVID-19 Pandemic situation and lockdown he could not file O.A. earlier. Limitation of one year expires in Sept.-2019. Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 10.01.2022 passed in Suo Moto Writ Petition (Civil)
