The Applicant was due to retire on 30.11.2021. He was holding the post of Additional Collector and was posted at CIDCO, Mumbai. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that as per file noting approved by Hon'ble Chief Minister proposal was accepted for giving proforma promotion in the cadre of Additional Collector (Selection Grade). In file noting it is stated that the Applicant was due to retired on 30.11.2021 but he is entitled for proforma promotion in the cadre of Additional Collector (Selection Grade). Interestingly, the file noting is dated 29.11.2021, whereas the Applicant was too retired on next date i.e. 30.11.2021. Thus before issuance of formal order of promotion he stands retired. In effect he stands retired from the post of Additional Collector without getting the order of promotion of selection grade. This being so, basically case is for grant of promotion in selection grade and it cannot be termed a case of Deemed Date of Promotion.</p> <p>3. In view of above, O.A. pertains to Division Bench.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant undertakes to file 2nd set of O.A.</p> <p>5. I/C. 
2. Ld. CPO has filed Praciepe dated 21.9.2022 for speaking to minutes of the order dated 15.9.2022 passed in the above OA.
