4. Learned Advocate for applicants concedes to the position that due to pendency of T.A, applicants have not agitated the question of seniority, which they propose to do by making suitable representation before competent authority.
5. In view of the foregoing, applicants shall have to represent before competent authority empowered to decide issue of seniority.

6. It is hoped that in case any such representation is made, and a case is made out the representation shall be decided in accordance with law.

7. T.A is disposed of with foregoing observation.

JUDGMENT

1. The Applicant who is working as Talathi has challenged the transfer order dated 25.09.2018 by which he has been transferred from Sajja Tarale to Sajja Marali, District Satara and sought interim relief to stay the operation and execution of transfer order.
2. The learned Advocate for the Applicant mainly challenged the transfer order on following grounds :
 - (a) The transfer of the Applicant is mid-term. He is Talathi, and therefore, the normal tenure is six years, but he has been transferred before the completion of six years;
 - (b) No prior approval of Civil Services Board is obtained;
 - (c) Transfer order has been issued without permission of Election Commissioner though the Applicant was engaged in election duty;

(d) The transfer, therefore, is in violation of the provisions of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred as 'Act 2005').

3. Per contra, the learned P.O. opposed the application on the ground that there are several complaints against the Applicant, and therefore, with prior approval of Sub-Divisional Officer, the transfer order has been issued. The learned P.O. has produced the copy of the order dated 06.09.2018, the copy of complaint, etc. which are marked as 'X' for the purpose of identification. As such, the learned P.O. sought to justify the transfer contending that it was necessary for administrative exigencies and cannot be faulted with.

4. Admittedly, the transfer proposal was not placed before Civil Services Board. Besides, there is no dispute that the normal tenure of Talathi is six years, but the Applicant was transferred mid-term. So far, the complaints against the Applicant are concerned, there is nothing to show that the complaints were investigated by the competent authority and are substantiated. In case of complaints against public servant, he can be transferred before completion of normal tenure provided the complaint should be investigated properly, and if found substance therein, then only such employee can be transferred with prior approval of concerned authority, as mandated by G.R. issued by G.A.D, dated 11th February, 2015.

5. The learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that, no other Talathi has been posted in the original place of posting of the Applicant. Besides, reliance is also placed on the order passed by this Tribunal in *O.A.No.908/2018 (A.J. Sayyad Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors, dated 17.10.2018)* wherein under identical circumstances, interim relief has been granted.

6. I am, therefore, satisfied that the impugned order is prima-facie in violation of 'Act 2005', and therefore, its operation and execution needs to be stayed.

7. In this circumstance it would be just to stay the exhibition and operation of impugned order till filing reply by the Respondents.

8. Admittedly, operation of the impugned order dated 25.9.2018 is stayed till filing reply of the Respondents.
9. Issue notice before admission returnable on 27.11.2018.
10. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
12. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
13. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
14. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
15. S.O. to 27.11.2018.
16. Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed to both the sides.
17. Learned P.O. for the Respondent is directed to communicate this order to the Respondents.






