Accordingly, O.A. was disposed of on 22,09.2000 with a direction to issue appropriate orders within two weeks. As there was no compliance within stipulated period, learned Counsel has filed praecipe for in tiating suo-moto contempt against the Principal Secretary. - 5. When the matter is taken up for admission and found that the matter itself is not maintainable.
- 6. Learned Counsel for the Applicant seeks permission to withdraw the O.A. with liberty to file fresh representation to the Government.
- 7. Allowed to withdraw the O.A. with liberty to file fresh representation to the Government, which may be considered on its own merit.
