- 6. The issue seems to be about entitlement of the applicant to pension on the basis of their last pay or the pay revised by the respondents by withdrawing benefits of Time Bound Promotion.
- 7. In view of the above, OAs need to be decided expeditiously. The pleadings are complete.
- 8. OAs be listed for final hearing at the stage of admission on 4.1.2021.
