3. All these matters are heard together. It is the case of the applicants in O.A. Nos. 473 & 475 of 2023 that after their transfers at particular place as mentioned in their respective transfer orders they

have been again shifted at some other places vide orders impugned in the respective OAs within a week after their joining at the transferred place; whereas it is the case of the applicant in O.A. No. 476/2023 that though he has not yet completed his ordinary tenure on the existing post, respondent No. 3 has been given posting in his place and no further posting is given to the applicant. In all the orders which are challenged in the present OAs the Government has invoked the powers under Section 4 (5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (for short 'the Transfer Act of 2005).

4. In O.A. No. 473/2023 learned counsel Shri Avishkar Shelke, learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 3 submitted that respondent No. 3 has been already relieved from his earlier post and in the order of his transfer itself it is mentioned that he will have to resume on the transferred post on 19.6.2023 or else he will be liable for the appropriate action. Learned counsel submitted that respondent No. 3 has already submitted his joining

report and same is acknowledged by the RDC. In the circumstances, according to the learned counsel the status quo order cannot be continued in the present matter. He further submitted that besides the post of the applicant one more post is lying vacant at Aurangabad. If this be so, it would be open for respondent No. 3 namely Shri R.K. Mendake, to make representation to the Government seeking his posting at Aurangabad on the said vacant post.

5. Today when the present matters are taken up for consideration, the learned Chief Presenting Officer produced the record received from the Government for perusal of the Tribunal. Learned C.P.O. was specifically asked to bring to the notice of the Tribunal the reasons recorded for the transfer of these applicants vide the impugned orders passed under Section 4(5) of the Transfer Act of 2005. Learned C.P.O. however, could not point out or bring to the notice of this Tribunal any such reason recorded in the documents produced by him before the Tribunal. Learned C.P.O. however, further submitted that the Government will file a detailed

affidavit in reply within two weeks from today. Patil has, therefore, made similar request for modifying the interim order or not continuing the interim order.

7. Though as has been submitted by learned counsel S/Shri Avishkar Shelke and Shamsunder B. Patil appearing for respondent No. 3 in respective

No.4 and measurement is done. Long jump is recorded as 4.92 m. and accordingly respondent No.4 was awarded 18 marks.

5. So far as written examination is concerned, it appears that the invigilator approached the respondent No.4, verified paper with him and gave the same back to the respondent No.4.
