category as stated in GR 05.12.1994 is not inconsonance with Reservation Act 2001 & especially as per Section 4(1), 4(3) of the said Maharashtra State Public Services Act, 2001 the GR of 05.12.1994 stand overruled. Hence Government has taken decision not to promote as per policy after Interchangeability.

4. In these view of submission, nothing remains in this matter. The learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre submits that these petitions were filed on the background of decision taken by the Department to consider the filling of vacancies in ST category of Sub-Divisional Engineers from the Diploma holder Junior Engineer of ST category, however for the temporary period of 1 year on adhoc basis. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre submits that after the lapse of temporary period of one year, the O.As have become infructuous. We accept the submission made by Mr. Chandratre and also learned PO. Both O.As have become infructuous and the same stand disposed off as such. No order as to costs.
