In O.A., the Applicant has challenged office order dated 20.04.2019 passed by Joint Commissioner of Police, (Administration) on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai stating that so long instructions are not issued from the Government in respect of payment of risk allowance being paid to police personnel working in Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad (BDDS) Unit, the Risk Allowance/Special Allowance should not be paid to them.
- 4. The Applicant is Police Hawaldar working in BDDS Unit, CP Mumbai. He was getting Risk Allowance / Special Allowance in terms of G.R. dated 22.11.1995. Later in view of 6th Pay Commission, the Government had issued another G.R. dated 03.09.2011 thereby determining how the Special Allowance / Risk Allowance to be paid. The Applicant and other police personnel serving in BDDS Unit were admittedly getting this Special Pay Allowance in terms of G.R. dated 03.09.2011.
- 5. However, the problem arises in view of the implementation of 7th Pay Commission w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

- Indeed, the office of CP, Mumbai had sent letter to Respondent No.1 - Additional Chief Secretary, Home on 02.04.2019 seeking guidance / direction about allowances to be paid to police personnel serving in BDDS in view of the 7^{th} Pay Commission report. It is on this background, the CP office, Mumbai by office order dated 20.04.2019 has stopped Allowance awaiting Special Pay of payment the communication from the Government on letter dated 02.04.2019. Though, the period near about three years is completing, no decision is taken till date.
- 7. Learned Counsel for the Applicant as well as learned P.O. has pointed out that pay and allowances are continued in respect of two units namely Quick Response Unit by G.R. dated 19.08.2020 and the police personnel serving in Special Operation Squad by G.R. dated 21.10.2020. However, no such decision is taken in respect of police personnel serving in BDDS Unit.
- 8. In view of above, this M.A. and O.A. deserves to be disposed of with suitable directions to Respondent No.1 to take appropriate decision on letter dated 02.04.2019 forwarded by CP, Mumbai to Government.
- 9. The Respondent No.1 is directed to take the decision about pay and allowances payable to police personnel in BDDS Unit in view of letter dated 02.04.2019 forwarded by CP, Mumbai within four weeks from today and the decision as the case may be, shall be communicated to the Applicant.
- 10. Misc. Application and Original Applications are accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs.


