2. The O.A. raises issue in respect of 9 answers to 9 questions as erroneous. In the 2nd answer key of the examination for the post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector which was conducted pursuant to the advertisement dated 02.09.2021 the learned C.P.O. objects that the Applicant No.1, Mr. J.M. Gund has raised objections only about 6 questions and not 9 questions and therefore it is to be restricted to only those 6 questions and answers. He further submits that the Applicant No.2 Mr. A.B. Mankar did not raise any objection to the 1st answer key therefore he has no locus to raise this objection at this stage. At Exhibit-F, page 79 objections are not of the Applicant No.1, but these objections are raised by Mr. Anirudha Khopade who is not the Applicant in the present O.A. The Applicant has raised objections of Question Nos.11, 17, 53, 60, 92 and 105.

3. The learned C.P.O. after taking instructions from the M.P.S.C. informs the Tribunal that general merit list was displayed and thereafter cut-off will be published and recommendations will be subsequently made.

4. M.P.S.C. not to proceed further and hold hand till filing of affidavit-in-reply. Adjourned to 28.03.2022 for reply.



The Applicant has challenged the orders dated 28.12.2021 as well as order dated 08.02.2022 whereby he was frequently shifted and transferred from one place to another and sought interim relief.</p> <p>3. O.A. was taken up for consideration of interim relief in the morning session but on request of learned P.O., it was kept for second session to take instructions from the Respondents.</p> <p>4. Learned P.O. on instructions fairly states that no PEB was taken before issuance of transfer orders dated 28.12.2021 and 08.02.2022. As such, the Commissioner, Railway Police in individual capacity passed these orders.</p> <p>5. The Applicant being Police Inspector, his tenure is two years at a Police Station or branch, 4 years in a District and 8 years in a Range in terms of Section 22(N) (c) of Maharashtra Police Act, 1951.</p> <p>6. Perusal of record reveals that the Applicant was serving at Kalyan Railway Police Station and by order dated 14.12.2020, he was transferred at Palghar Railway Police Station. However, the Respondents by order dated 18.12.2021 temporarily shifted him from Palghar Railway Police Station to Main Control Room Railway Police Mumbai. However, again the Respondents transferred the Applicant to Mumbai Central Railway Police Station by order dated 08.02.2022. Thus, <i>prima-facie</i>, the Applicant is subjected to transfer twice in a short period without recommendation of PEB.</p>

7. In view of above, I am satisfied that *prima-facie* impugned transfer order is not in consonance with the provisions of Maharashtra Police Act, 1951. Interim relief in terms of Clause 10(a) is granted in respect of transfer order dated 08.02.2022.
8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 13.04.2022.
9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
11. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
12. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
13. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

2. In this O.A., challenge is to the order of punishment post departmental inquiry. In D.E., twenty-two witnesses were examined. During the course of argument, one submission was advanced by learned Counsel for the Applicant that the record does not indicate what was exact cross examination to the witnesses and on this line, submission was advanced that there was no fair opportunity of cross examination on the witnesses.
3. In view of above submission, the directions were given to learned P.O. to show original record of inquiry containing deposition of witnesses.
4. Learned P.O. has tendered the record of D.E. which is at page Nos.165 and 339 of PB.
5. Perusal of deposition of witnesses reveals that opportunity of cross examination was given to the Applicant and he put certain questions to the witnesses.
6. Having gone through the record of inquiry, learned Counsel for the Applicant fairly concedes that the Applicant was given opportunity to cross examination of witnesses and is not a case of denial of opportunity to cross examination of the witnesses. He made specific statement that he will not raise the issue of non opportunity of cross examination in the matter. His statement is recorded accordingly.






