ORDER

1. Heard Shri M.R Patil, learned advocate for the applicant and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.



2. Applicant has approached this Tribunal by present O.A with the relief as follows:-

“11(a) to restrain the Respondents from finalizing and declaring the recommendations for appointment by selection to IAS for the Select List 2017.”

(Quoted from page 16 of O.A)

3. Applicant's grievance is that his candidature is declined erroneously and illegally.

4. According to the applicant the information as has emerged from Exh. A-5, page 39 is based on erroneous background, namely:-

- (i) Applicant's A.C.Rs have been wrongly taken into account.
- (ii) That though as per Government Notification at Exh. A-10 dated 24.12.2004 all Group-A posts, previously class-I are declared equivalent to Deputy Collector in Civil Service, Applicant's candidature is wrongly rejected.

5. The case was heard on day to day basis.

6. G.A.D has shown openness to examine applicant's objections as to error in recognizing ACRs. Applicant's claim as to his A.C.Rs being 'A+' is accepted.

7. Applicant's case now stuck at second point. According to G.A.D, the applicant has not served for required period in the post 'equivalent to Deputy Collector in Civil Services'.

8. To assail the ground of declinment, the Applicant has relied upon the notification dated 24.12.2004. Relevant text reads as follows:-

“2. In fulfillment of the requirements of the above provisions and also in order to meet the eligibility conditions with regards to the recommendations made in respect of the Non SCS

officers, in exercise of power conferred by Sub Regulations (iii) of Regulation 4(1) of Indian Administrative Service (Appointment by Selection) Regulations, 1997, the Government is pleased to order that, barring three services, viz. (1) State Police Service (2) State Forest Service and (3) Judicial Service, all Group 'A' posts (previously class I posts) in all the Departments under the Government of Maharashtra are declared equivalent to the post of Deputy Collector in the State Civil Service, for the limited purpose specified in Regulation *ibid.*"

(Quoted from page 54, Exh. A-10 of O.A)

9. Plain reading of the notification reveals that any distinction based on scale of pay of various cadres/posts is not made and all Group-A officers are declared by the Government to be equivalent to Deputy Collector in civil services.

10. The case was adjourned to find out as to whether Government would reconsider applicant's candidature.

11. In the afternoon learned C.P.O has appeared and on instructions from Mrs Savita Rishi Bandekar-Deshmukh, Deputy Secretary, G.A.D, Mantralaya, Mumbai, and has made statement as follows:-

(i) Government may consider to reexamine the position as declared through the notification dated 24.12.2004, Exh. A-10, including to widen the scope or remove the ambiguity.

(ii) However, it would not be possible to make a concession allowing the applicant to appear for the examination.

12. It has to be borne in mind that what the officers or the bureaucrats feel is not the law. Had the notification carved out, the pay scale which being equal, the office be treated equally to Deputy Collector, is not the scheme or intendment of the notification. On the other hand, notification presupposes variety of pay scales and



different posts, however, broader classification as Group-A, and hence omits to make any differentiation based on scales of pay.

13 Notification further presupposes that for the purpose of nomination to IAS all cadres in Civil Services in Group-A are treated equal to Deputy Collector.

14. Introduction of one's notion as a rule is thus improper and an act of legislation while doing a Ministerial act and an executive business.

15. After considering rival submissions, we are of the considered view that the objection of the Respondents to the effect that the applicant does not fall in the category of "posts equivalent to the post of Deputy Collector" is based on applying or employing a yardstick which is based on 'notion' than an existing rule or stipulation, because any such prescription does not find place in the notification where distinction based on pay scale is permitted or laid down.

16. Considering that the examinations are due to be held on 25.5.2018, we think it proper to allow the applicant to appear for the examination and keep the issue open.

17. We hold that in these premises, the Applicant cannot be refused to appear for the test. However, the question as to whether applicant is eligible is kept open and result of test of applicant shall be subject to outcome of the fresh decision on applicant's representation by the Government.


18. We, therefore, direct that the applicant should be permitted to appear for the test. The result of the performance of the applicant be declared, and it shall be subject to outcome of Government's decision.

19. If Government decides adverse to the applicant either in the matter of examination or in the matter of eligibility, applicant shall be free to challenge the same.

20. In the matter of deciding applicant's representation, it shall be highly appreciated if applicant is given a personal hearing so that the point relied upon by him could be properly examined.

21. Applicant is directed to furnish his email id to G.A.D so that decision as may be reached by the Government could be communicated to him.

22. Original Application is disposed of with above directions.
